RULES OF THE SPRING ROAD SCHOOL PARKING LOT

When driving your car in the Spring Road parking lot, you must follow these rules:

- ★ Drive slowly and always watch for children. For the safety of our children, drivers should not exceed 10 mph in our parking lot.
- ★ Follow the yellow arrows in the parking lot. NO U-Turns allowed.
- ★ Walk your child to and from the building when parked in the lot.

There are TWO lanes to **EXIT** the parking lot.

- A Right lane exits the parking lot as a right turn only.
- Left lane exits the parking lot as a left turn only.

There are TWO lanes to ENTER the parking lot:

- The left lane to enter is to be used when parking in the lot. There is no idling, dropping off, or picking up while in this lane. Drivers using this lane are turning left to park. Once in the parking lot, park the car in a designated parking spot, and walk your child through the parking lot to the playground or building. Do not drive a continuous loop through the parking lot.
- The lane on the right when entering the parking lot (end lane closest to the playground) is for drivers remaining in the car. This lane is the drop off/pick up lane. Drivers in the drop off/pick up lane MUST remain in the car at all times. Student(s) must exit the car from the passenger side.

DROP OFF/PICK UP LANE

AM DROP OFF: When dropping off students, please pull up to the end of the sidewalk near the gym doors to begin drop off. Students exit the car using the passenger side door. Adults need to remain in the car. After dropping off your child(ren), you may signal to enter the inside lane to go around the other cars waiting in the drop off lane. Buses will be using the drop off lane also. Cars waiting in the drop off lane should be preparing the children in the car for the drop off: gather belongings with a kiss goodbye for the school day.

PM PICK UP: All drivers picking up will wait in the vehicle. The first car in the pick-up line will stop at the tip of the landscaped area near the American Flag.


