## WE NEED YOUR HELP NOW!!!!

As with many things in our lives, we as parents/guardians, are stretched thin but still want to be involved. Up until this point, you may think things run really smoothly with all of the PTO sponsored activities. For the 2019-20 school year, things are going to need to drastically change because at the end of this current school year, in June 2019 over 70% of our active PTO members are graduating with their children. At the end of the 2020 school year, an additional 20% of our active PTO parents will be graduating. WE do <u>not</u> have enough volunteers and WE will <u>not</u> able to sustain any of our PTO sponsored activities starting in the 2019-20 school year and if we don't have volunteers REALLY SOON to lead the PTO and support the activities of the PTO, then Spring Road will <u>no longer</u> have a PTO. #### PTO Executive Committee - Accepting Nominations for 2019 - 20!!!

A summary of the Executive Committee members are:

- The **Co-Presidents** shall preside at all meetings of the PTO at which one of the presidents must be present.
- The Recording Secretary shall keep PTO records, take and record minutes, and handle correspondence.
- The Coordinating Secretary assists in coordinating activities and putting together the PTO calendar.

PTO Executive Committee Nominations will be accepted now through May 14 at the beginning the PTO meeting prior to elections

#### Other Volunteer Opportunities, these positions are not elected and any of them can be co-chaired.

**Fundraising** – the committee develops the fundraising plan the <u>next</u> school year's activities, events and fundraisers with the assistance and input of the standing and special committee chairs to allow the PTO to meet budgetary and project needs.

**Social Committee** – the committee comes up with ideas for social events for Spring Road families like dances, bowling night, game night and bingo night.

**General Mills Box Tops** – assist in collecting, counting and sending of the box tops two times a year – we are looking for a couple of people to assist and a person to co-chair the committee.

**Art, Craft and Market Day Fair** – This is a new event to be held in March for the 2019-20 school year. The committee will work with getting vendors for the fair and advertising for the fair.

**Monthly PTO newsletter** – work with the coordinating secretary to update the PTO monthly newsletter with current information to be publish at the beginning of each month. All of the templates and information from last year will be available to you and you can work on it at home.
