FREE Summer Reading Program

Are you looking for a summer reading program for your kids? Look no further than the Neenah Library! It is free for babies through teens. The weekly rewards are awesome. Neenah Library's SOAR into Summer Reading – starts on Monday, June 3 and will run through Friday, August 9. There will be family entertainment with music, magic and trick dogs, weekly story times, book groups, STEAM programs, and a reading incentive program. Registration is open now (in person or online); kids may pick up their reading logs starting Monday, June 3. Completing the summer reading challenge makes participants eligible to select a free book. All programs and activities are free.

New this year is Chapter-a-Day offered Mondays-Thursdays at noon. Kids ages 18 and under can pick up a free lunch at the library and enjoy it while listening to books read aloud by your favorite librarians.
