## **KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT**

Five-year-old Kindergarten (5K) enrollment is scheduled for the week of February 12 – February 15, 2018 (Monday through Thursday). Enrollment is 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Neenah Joint School District (NJSD) Administration Building, 410 South Commercial Street. Enrollment will be open until 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 13 only. All information necessary for enrollment will be mailed to families with kindergarten age students on January 18. You can also find enrollment information on the NJSD website [www.neenah.k12.wi.us](http://www.neenah.k12.wi.us) Students currently attending Four-year-old Kindergarten (4K) in the NJSD who plan to attend 5K next year in the NJSD do not need to complete enrollment paperwork. ## **KEYBOARD CLASSES**

The Neenah Joint School District is sponsoring after school group Keyboard classes for elementary students in grades 1 through 5. This is the 21st year of the keyboard program. Classes meet once a week for 1/2 hour for ten weeks at Horace Mann Middle School. The cost is \$40.00 per student plus book. Classes begin the week of February 5th. Forms have been sent home. ## **NJSD MOVING COMPANY**

The NJSD Moving Company provides a movement break involving proprioceptive input for students who need such input to better regulate their neurology. It's for students who may be over-stimulated and need deep pressure input. An over-stimulated student may bump into things, be disruptive, and seem to have "too much energy". It's also for under-stimulated students who may appear sleepy and lethargic. The Moving Company is a universal system and may be used safely with all students. There are 4 "docks" at different points around Tullar. Each item is labeled or tagged with an "NJSD Moving Company" sign. Students can carry or drag these items from one dock to another to help with regulating their bodies. Students carry weighted items such as backpacks, books, emptied out detergent jugs with sand to designated "docks" throughout the building. Doing these movement breaks can help in aiding the student to be more focused and ready to learn in their classroom.
