



Foreign Exchange Program Policies

- Neenah High School will accept a maximum of eight (8) exchange students per school year. We will accept two students per agency, and only one per country.
- Students must be at least sixteen years of age by September 1.
- Students must have enough credits (per our standards) to enter grade 11. All students will attend Neenah High School as Juniors (Grade 11) during their exchange year.
- Students must possess a J-1 student VISA to be in the United States and attend Neenah High School.
- Students must attend Neenah High School for the entire school year (2 semesters).
- Neenah High School does not accept single semester exchange students.
- Neenah High School does not accept students who have already graduated from high school in their country.
- **The cut-off date for applications is June 30.**
- All exchange students must be placed through an agency and have a host family assigned before registering at Neenah High School. Host families must reside within the Neenah Joint School District.
- Agencies must be on the current Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) Advisory List.
