## **SCHOOL SAFETY REMINDERS...AND SOME CHANGES**

Families, the following are some procedures for visiting Tullar School. Though parents are welcome at Tullar, we are working to maintain a safe environment so please be reminded of the following guidelines:

- 1) Always enter the building through the main door. Do not enter through any other locked doors which have been opened by students exiting the building at the end of the day. Please do not let anyone else in behind you after you have been buzzed in.
- 2) Check in at the office every time you are buzzed in. If you need an item delivered to your child, the office will call down to their classroom and be sure your student receives their item. Parents will only be allowed down the hallways if they are volunteering or here for a scheduled meeting.
- 3) If your child arrives late for school, please sign them in to the office. Your child can then walk themselves to class.
- 4) If you are picking your child up early or for an appointment, arrive 5 minutes early and we will call down to their classroom and have them get ready at that time and come to the office. You always need to sign your student in and out at the office in the green book.
- 5) At the end of the day, parents entering the building to pick up your student will need to remain just outside the office and pick your child up from there (parents will not be allowed to go to classrooms for pick up).
