If this describes your child then he or she may be a highly intellectual student that would benefit from participating in our Magnet Class for High Ability Students. Magnet Classes are designed to offer students 53,976 opportunities to work at a greater depth and/or breadth or at a faster pace than in the regular classroom setting.
