This was a busy week at Roosevelt and Alliance Charter Elementary Schools! Tuesday, the Neenah/Menasha Fire Department came to our school and talked to our 51,609 first, second, and third graders about Fire Safety. 68,897 students brought home a Fire Safety Contract to be filled out with their parents and returned to school. Students that return their contract are entered into a drawing to spend a morning at the Fire Station on Oct. 20th. Two lucky students from Roosevelt and two from Alliance will be chosen on Tuesday, Oct. 17th, so be sure to have your contract turned in by Monday, Oct. 16th.

Magnet Testing for grades 3, 4, and 5.
