Lock Down Drill- Monday, Sept. 18th

On Monday, Sept. 18th we will be having an all school lock down safety drill beginning at 2:15 pm. The drill will last approximately 15 minutes. The purpose of this drill is to prepare our 61,316 students and staff for any crisis situation that may occur, making it necessary for us to lock down classrooms and/or the entire building. Students have been notified of the upcoming drill, and were given the opportunity to ask questions. During this drill the office will be closed so that all staff can practice the safety procedure. Phones will not be answered during this time. The drill should be over at approximately 2:30 pm. If you have any questions or concerns about this drill, please contact Mrs. Luft.

Report Card Change

Starting this school year, report cards will be distributed at the end of quarter 2 and quarter 4 instead of each quarter for students in 4K-grade 5. Progress regarding your child will continue to be shared with you personally by your child’s classroom teacher during Parent/Teacher Conferences during quarters 1 and 3. Your school will work with you to get student progress updates if you are not able to attend a Parent/Teacher Conference.

The District is making the change because there are a number of ways that teachers and parents regularly communicate about student progress including email, student planners, take-home folders, classroom newsletters, daily notebooks, and personal contact. In addition, nearly 100% of our parents attend elementary Parent/Teacher Conferences and the many additional means for daily and/or weekly communication has lessened the need for formal reporting.
