## Camp Sessions:

### **Session 1**

**8:15 – 9:00 am**

**Cost \$30**

The focus of this session is for the camper to be comfortable in the water and familiar with floating, kicking and basic swimming skills. This session is recommended for beginner swimmers, or 1st and 2nd graders.

### **Session 2**

**9:15 -10:30 am**

**Cost \$40**

This is recommended for 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> graders or intermediate level swimmers. This group will have a wide range of abilities. The instruction will be adapted to fit the individual needs of the camper.

### **Session 3**

**10:45 am - Noon**

**Cost \$40**

This is recommended for 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders or kids with swim team experience. The instruction will work on stroke technique, starts, turns and competitive swimming strategies. Dryland activities will also be incorporated into daily activities.

**\*\*Siblings may attend the same session, regardless of grade levels.**
