## Example EFN Grants

### Who is EFN?

The Educational Foundation of Neenah ("EFN") is a 501(c)(3) organization which provides grants for new and innovative programming to educators within the Neenah Joint School District. An 11-member board meets 4 times during the school year to review grant requests. EFN Board members come from a variety of professional backgrounds and experiences.

### How does EFN work?

Educators complete grant requests and submit them to their supervisors. If the request meets NJSD strategic objectives, it is submitted to the EFN board for consideration. EFN reviews dozens of requests each year.

In addition to its grant program, EFN also administers pass-through donations from donors who are passionate about particular areas of education. Examples of pass through donations include the Horan Book Fund for Roosevelt School, the Theissen-Bemis fund for special education, the Helen Rose Chrapla and David Brian Chrapla Scholarship Awards and funds for musical instruments.

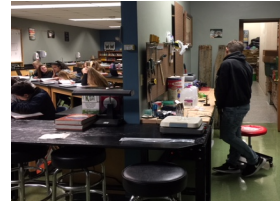

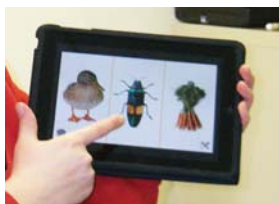

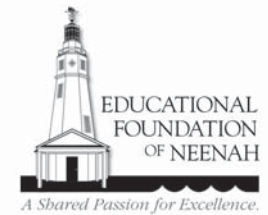
