We are looking for volunteers for the 2017-18 school year. Please let us know if you are interested in being a part of or even chairing or co-chairing one of our committees. If interested, please contact the Spring Road PTO via SpringRoadPTO@gmail.com and let us know what you are interested in and if you would like to chair/co-chair a committee or just help out. Time commitments listed by the activity is an approximate amount of time for based on previous people's experience. Most committees have co-chairs leading the team.

Volunteering opportunities for the 2017-18 school year are:

- Book Fair / Birthday books (prefer co-chairs) (Time commitment: unavailable and very intense for the weeks surrounding the book fair)
 - recruit and coordinate workers
 - o work at the sale during the event
 - coordinate the marking, sales, set-up and dear-down staffing, inventory control and overall operations of the fall and spring book fairs
- Room Rep /Teacher Appreciation (prefer co-chairs) (Time commitment: 6-10 hours per school year) to:
 - organize teacher appreciation activities (Examples only: lunch/dinner for Parent/Teacher Conferences)
 - o coordinate recognition for Teacher Appreciation Week in May
- Social (prefer co-chairs) (Time commitment: 5-6 hours per social)
 - determine if there is a theme (Example: movie night, costume party, dance, rodeo, bingo/silent auction)
 - o recruit and coordinate any entertainment
 - o Recruit and coordinate the set-up and dear-down/clean-up staffing,
- Enrichment (a.k.a. Cultural events) (prefer co-chairs) (Time commitment: 6-10 hours per event):
 - coordinate 1-2 events/activities per school year of performers, instructors, etc. that will encompass learning or appropriate age-level entertainment for the entire student body with the school administrators, Music Teacher and/or STEM coordinator and the PTO Executive Committee to provide a enrichment opportunity for Spring Road students.
- Cherry Dale/Fall fundraiser (Time commitment: 10 hrs)
 - o verify order forms will be sent home to each student
 - o coordinate the inventory control and overall operations of the fundraiser
- **Box Tops** (Time commitment: 5 hrs each for the fall and spring collections) shall:
 - provide Box Top collection sheets to school prior to the start of the collection to have translations, if needed, to be completed, and sent out for printing, collating, and distribution.
 - recruit and coordinate workers to tally the individual classrooms total for the fall and spring collections
 - mail the box tops in to receive funds for the Spring Road PTO
- Spirit Wear (Time commitment: 5 hrs in Fall)
 - Setup samples and bring to Open House.
 - Collect orders to place orders to make spirit wear and distribute finished product
- Open House (Time commitment: 2-5 hrs in Fall)
 - o recruit and coordinate any fundraising activities (example: food trucks or other activities)
 - o recruit and coordinate the set-up and dear-down/clean-up staffing
- **Square 1** (Time commitment: 5 hrs in Spring)
 - Work with Spring Road Art teacher for students' art projects
 - o verify order forms will be sent home to each student
 - o coordinate the inventory control and overall operations of the Square 1 art
- Eaton's (Time commitment: 5 hrs in Spring)
 - o verify order forms will be sent home to each student
 - o coordinate the inventory control and overall operations of all of the Eaton's Pizza
