Foreign Exchange Program Policies

- Neenah High School will accept a maximum of ten exchange students per school year. We will accept two students per agency, and only one per country. Exceptions may be made if the maximum number of exchange students (10) do not enroll at Neenah High School in a given year.
- Students must be at least sixteen years of age.
- Students must have enough credits to enter grade 11 (equivalent to a Neenah High School junior).
- Students must possess a student VISA (or have legal documentation to be in the United States).
- Students must attend Neenah High School for the entire school year (2 semesters).
- Neenah High School does not accept single semester exchange students.
- Neenah High School does not accept students who have already graduated from high school in their country.
- Students, in grade 12, who pass all required courses and complete all required graduation credits are eligible to participate in our graduation ceremony and will be awarded a Neenah High School Diploma. Students, in grade 12, not completing all required Neenah High School courses and graduation credits may participate in our graduation ceremony and will be awarded an Honorary Neenah High School Diploma.
- If a student does not have enough credits to enter grade 12 at Neenah High School, but were scheduled to graduate from their school the year they attend Neenah High School, they must have official documentation to substantiate this.
- Cut-off date for registration is August 1.
- All exchange students must be placed through an agency and have a host family assigned before registering at Neenah High School. Host families must reside within the Neenah Joint School District.
- Agencies must be on the current Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) Advisory List.
