Dear Parent/Guardian:

It's time to start Kindergarten! We know your child is ready to take the next step in his or her NJSD journey and that step is Kindergarten! We are already planning to welcome your child to Kindergarten next year. Below, you will find information about enrolling your child in Kindergarten for the 2024-25 school year.

- If your child will not be attending NJSD's 5K program in 2024-25, please call 920-751-6800 ASAP so we can make space for others.
- If your child *will* be attending NJSD's 5K program in 2024-25, you don't need to do anything; we'll assume your child will be attending 5K in the Fall of 2024-25. There is no need to call us or actively enroll.

A few important things for children attending NJSD's 5K program:

- Your child will be expected to attend the school within the attendance area of your residence. You can find out your child's home school using the District's website (www.neenah.k12.wi.us). Once you're there, click on the "Enrollment" tab to access the boundary map. *It is important to note that the District is currently revising its elementary school boundaries. You can find both the current boundaries and the proposed boundaries in the "Enrollment" tab of the NJSD website. You will be notified by the principal of your child's school assignment later in spring. The principal will provide further information about Kindergarten orientation at your child's school.*
- You may request to attend a school other than your assigned school by completing a Boundary Exemption Form. If approved, you would be responsible for transportation to your requested school.
- In some instances, it is necessary to assign students to a school other than the home school.
- If you are interested in your child attending NJSD's Montessori charter school, Alliance Charter Elementary School for the 2024-25 school year, please contact Garrett Zimmerman, principal of Alliance Charter Elementary School.
