## Teachers' Report:

12/6 - K and 1/2/3 will be going to Festival Foods

1/2/3 classrooms recently had Jon and Tasha Morgan speak about flight.

### Treasurer's report:

Booster-a-thon is complete and laps are entered. Total earned was \$11,902, short of initial goal of \$12,277 that would cover all basic operating costs.

- -Overall goal of \$20,000, which would have covered all new keyboards and equipment (adapters, stands, stools, teacher's keyboard) was not obtained.
- Additional \$3000 is needed for operational budget, therefore will do 2 smaller spring fundraisers

Spring Fund Raiser – would like to tie into Montessori week 2/24 – 3/2 and Maria Montessori's 150<sup>th</sup> birthday by doing an "I (heart) Montessori" fund raiser. Asking for donations and would show progress on the school doors. May use a Go Fund Me page (cost of 2.9% + \$0.30/ transaction) to make donating easier from friends and family.

- Currently brainstorming a family friendly event to tie into this to make fundraising easier.
  - If doing a raffle, the licensing process needs to be started now
- Community education regarding Montessori would be a nice tie in to reach additional avenues for donations

Funset Blvd – there will be more nights in the future, dates will be shared as they are known

Brainstorming Ideas for fundraiser:

- Restaurant Night: having food trucks, Paul Hartman has offered his service of selling smoked meats during this event
- Dueling Pianos or Karaoke
- Auctioning kids art projects projects created around a theme. Ashay will get more information.

Charitable Donations: There was concern brought forward from a parent that she was unable to give a flat donation for a specific event or activity in the past and would like to know how and if this can be done.

YES! – a check can be written to ACEC to go directly to our budget or specific fund. ACEC is a 501c3 and will provide a letter to donator that a donation was received.

- If a specific activity or event is sponsored by a person/business, recognition should be given to contributors
- Also please ask your company/place of employment if they offer a company match for donation. End of year is a good time to donate for tax purposes.
- Julie Gerstle will forward a letter to Erika G. that has already been created asking for company matching donation at year's end.
- Fundraising discussion tabled until December meeting to make decision on which events to move forward with in the spring.
- Would like to create a document specifying dollar amounts needed for various budget items

### Open Forum:

Parents' concern that keyboards are not being replacement as they were under the assumption that Booster-a-thon dollars were for that. If we reached the full \$20k amount, the keyboards could have been replaced, unfortunately not enough was raised for this to happen.

\$21,000 needed to replace all keyboards and associated equipment @ \$600/keyboard. Would like to budget for replacing 1 row (6 keyboards) at a time. Considering pushing this purchase to summer, and possibly next budget year (July) to have additional funds available after spring fundraisers.
