At the end of each school year, the classroom teachers, support teachers, and principal work together to determine classroom placement for the upcoming school year. As we start planning for the next school year, I want to provide you with an opportunity to participate in helping your child have a successful school year. We devote our expertise and time toward creating classroom assignments that ensure balance for optimal teaching and learning. Several important elements are considered when making class placements. The elements considered are:

- individual factors specific to each child
- academic, gender, and ethnic balance of the classroom strengths and styles of individual teachers
- teacher input and recommendations
- parent input and recommendations

If you would like to participate in this process, please request a "Parent Information for Student Placement" form from the school office. We will consider parent input carefully before making any placement decisions. Since the criteria listed above will be used to determine class placements, please do not request an individual teacher.

If you have more specific information to share about your child, please write a letter indicating the single most important factor you would like us to consider. If you have more than one factor, please prioritize them. Submitted letters and

questionnaires will be reviewed carefully by the following: current grade level teachers, proceeding grade level teachers, and the principal. Attach the letter to the parent information form upon submission. The form and additional information must be submitted to the principal no later than May 15th. Information received after this date cannot be considered because our placement process will have already begun. Making changes in placement after the process has begun, because of information received after the due date, compromises the placement priorities listed in this letter. We will still accept the parent information as valuable information to share with your child's upcoming teacher.

We look forward to learning more about your child from the parent perspective. Please note that completing the form and providing additional information is voluntary. All student placements will receive the same care and consideration whether or not additional information is provided.
