## Report Cards – home on January 31

Report cards will be sent home with students on Wednesday, January 31. All parents and guardians are strongly encouraged to engage in conversation with your child about his/her report card. When talking to your child, use the report card as a conversation starter. Ask your child how he/she thinks he/she did this semester in school. Give specific praise for areas of strength, and great effort made. Set goals for areas that are a challenge, and ask how you, as the parent, can support. All parents are welcome to contact the teachers that work with your child to learn more about additional supports needed, or ask questions. After the report card has been reviewed, parents or guardians must sign and return it to school by Monday, February 12.
