Marsden's Math Minute



Think about the common expression...**"in a minute"**. We say it to our children and our children say it to us all the time. My challenge to you is to make the minutes with your child count! One way to do this is to literally count. Here are just a few ideas of how...

- *Count forward by 1 beginning at 1
- *Count forward by 1 beginning at a random number
- *Count back by 1 from a random number
- *Count by 5 to 100
- *Count by 10 to 100
- *Count back by 5 beginning at 100
- *Count back by 10 beginning at 100
- *Count by 10 beginning at 4
- *Count back by 10 beginning at 93
- *Skip count by 2, 3, and/or 4
- *Count forward by $\frac{1}{2}$ to 10
- *Count back by $\frac{1}{3}$ from 5

You can have your child do all the counting or you can take turns. It's easy to do and can be done almost anywhere. Have fun and make the minutes count!
