Class Placements for 2019-2020

- Parent input

If you would like to provide input, please request a “Parent Information for Student Placement” form from your child’s teacher or the school office. We will consider parent input carefully when making decisions about placement of classroom for the upcoming school year. Information must be received by your child’s current teacher or principal by Wednesday, May 22nd. Please know that all student placements are given the same care and consideration whether or not additional parent information is provided.
