PBIS

Parent Survey & Volunteers Needed

This year we implemented PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports). The purpose of our implementation was to use common language and expectations throughout the school with all students. Students were taught and retaught expected behaviors throughout the school year. In addition to the teaching of expected behaviors, student efforts with making expected behavior choices were recognized at the end of each week and quarter. We are interested in receiving parent feedback on the implementation of this new behavioral system.
