We are off to a great start at Spring Road Elementary School. We are starting our 2<sup>nd</sup> year of PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports). Thank you to all of the students and parents for providing us with feedback last year through our end of the year PBIS survey. We received 23 completed parent surveys and 167 student surveys. The PBIS Committee met this summer to review all of the surveys and engaged in discussion about the implementation of the suggestions received.

Spring Road Staff will continue to recognize students making expected behavior choices during the school day. When positive behaviors are displayed, students are “rockin’ it the roadrunner way” and able to receive a “Rockin’ Roadrunner” ticket. Students may earn a ticket on the bus, at school or as a class. All adults working at Spring Road School have the ability to give a rockin’ roadrunner ticket to students; as many as they want every school day. At the end of the week 6 rockin’ roadrunner students have a chance to win a free Culvers scoop of custard or a free meal with sundae at Benvenutos in Oshkosh. please keep the crosswalk open

As you likely have experienced, the drop off lane gets backed up in the morning around 7:45 a.m. Please be mindful of keeping the crosswalk open to allow our crossing guard to safely get students across the street. The crossing guard cannot cross students if drivers are blocking the crosswalk. Once the clock strikes 7:45 a.m., the traffic will start moving in our parking lot, and will open the ability to turn onto Spring Road Drive without blocking the crosswalk. Supervision begins on our playground at 7:45 a.m. Students are welcome on the playground at or after that time. Thank you to all of the parents who wait patiently for this time before having your child/children exit your vehicle.

Students will be dismissed from school at 3:05 p.m. With almost 400 students exiting the building at the same time, you may see your child outside as late as 3:10 p.m., but hopefully no later.

The first bell rings at 8:05 a.m. This bell indicates a need for all students to line up. At 8:15 a.m. a second bell rings to indicate the start of the instructional day. Students must be in their seats ready to learn by 8:15 a.m. *NOTE: students arriving 10 minutes or more after the 8:15 a.m. bell will be marked as absent for the a.m.*

In an effort to make sure your child is safe and dismissed properly, parents must wait outside for students to be dismissed. Teachers of primary aged children (K-3) will walk students outside, and wait until the child is picked up. Parents parked in the lot must walk to pick up child from the outside of the building near the main entrance. We will not dismiss a student to walk/run across the parking lot to meet a parent.

### Drop Off/Pick Up Lane

The south lane of the parking lot (farthest right when entering our parking lot), is a drop off/pick up lane **ONLY**. Parents choosing to use this lane **MUST** remain in the car. If a parent needs to get out of the car to enter the building or assist a child exiting or entering the car, the parking lot must be used.

### Inclement Weather

When the yellow, smiley face is posted on the front doors of the school, students may enter the building. The smiley face will be posted anytime between 7:45 a.m. and 8:05 a.m. when it is raining or the temperature is below zero.

Students will enter the building, sit at his/her assigned locker or coat hook and engage in an independent silent activity: read a book, draw a picture, study word work, relax.

Supervision will not be present outside on days with inclement weather as they will be monitoring students inside.
