Parking Lot

Thank you to the parents that have remained mindful of the rules of the parking lot throughout the school day. I recently met with Adam Krieger, Facilities Manager for the Neenah Joint School District. The purpose of our meeting was for him to observe the current flow of our parking lot, and discuss possible improvements. At this time, the current flow of our parking lot provides the most efficient use of space and allows for best flow of traffic.

In conversation with the Fox Crossing Police Department, we discussed the congestion on Spring Road Drive. Please make every effort to enter the parking lot for the pick up lane (pick up lane is the south lane that requires the driver to remain in the car) from the south; traveling northbound. Do NOT leave your car unattended on Spring Road Drive. There is no parking on Spring Road Drive, and citations will be issued for cars left unattended.

The Fox Crossing Police Department understands our challenges of limited space in our parking lot, no off street parking, and a high volume of traffic. With this understanding, it is permissible to arrange for student pick up on Cooke Road. What does this look like? When your child is dismissed from school, s/he walks along the building toward County Road II to Cooke Road and crosses the street with the assistance of the Crossing Guard to meet the adult driver IN the car (driver MUST remain in the car while idling on Cooke Road).
