Forward Exam

Students in grades 3-5 throughout the state of Wisconsin will take the Wisconsin Forward Exam. This assessment will be used to measure how well students are mastering the Wisconsin State Standards. The Wisconsin Forward Exam is given in grades 3-8 in English/Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics. Students in grades 4 and 8 will also take a Science test, and students in grades 4, 8 and 10 will have a Social Studies test. The Forward Exam is an online test that will include multiple-choice questions, short-answer questions and writing.

The 4th graders at Spring Road School will begin taking the Social Studies portion of the test on Tuesday, March 21. Specific testing dates will be sent home with your child. In addition to the testing dates, a brochure will be shared with families to further explain the test.

Sample or practice test questions are available to students, teachers, parents, and community members at dpi.wi.gov/assessment/forward/sample-items. Students across the district will be using the Online Tools Training (OTT) during the school day to learn how to navigate within the online system.
