This scholarship awards two former Spring Road School students \$500 each for college. Good luck Madeline, Haafsah and all of our former Spring Road Seniors with your future endeavors.

Even though the PTO has enjoyed supporting the success of our former students, the Arthur W. Prosek Scholarship will no longer be awarded. With the support of Mr. Prosek and the unanimous vote of the parents and staff present at the May 18th PTO meeting, the \$1,000 awarded for the scholarships will now be used to supplement the cost of a field trip. After discussion at the PTO meeting, the \$1,000 will be used to fund an annual 5th grade field trip.
