PBIS Update

Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports

Spring Road Students had a great week demonstrating expected behaviors. We are referring to these behaviors as the *Rockin' Roadrunner Way!* Students have an opportunity to be recognized throughout the school day by all staff for demonstrating safe, respectful and responsible behaviors. Recognition may be awarded to individual students or to an entire class. Students know they are being recognized as a Rockin' Roadrunner when they receive positive reinforcement verbally and are given a ticket. All tickets are collected in the students' homeroom. At the end of each week, the tickets in each room are tallied. The class with the most tickets receives the traveling Rockin' Roadrunner for the week. Congratulations to the 1st graders in Mrs. Martis' class for the most tickets for safe, respectful and responsible behaviors. Ask your child at the end of each week to find out if his/her class won.
