# I-41/Winchester Road/County II long-term closures begin Monday in Winnebago County

45-day and 36-day ramp closures

(Fox Valley) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Northeast Region office in Green Bay is announcing long-term ramp closures at the I-41/Winchester Road (County II) interchange in Winnebago County to begin on Monday, September 19. Details of the closures are as follows:

- Southbound I-41 off-ramp to Winchester Road to close for 45-days on September 19
- Southbound I-41 on-ramp from Winchester Road to close for 36-days on September 19
- Northbound I-41 on-ramp from Winchester Road to close for 45-days on September 19
- Winchester Road under I-41 will remain open but may have various single lane closures

### All lane restrictions and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change.
