Report Cards Change in Practice

Starting this school year, report cards will be distributed at the end of quarter 2 and quarter 4 instead of each quarter for students in 4K-grade 5. Progress regarding your child will continue to be shared with you personally by your child's classroom teacher during Parent/Teacher Conferences during quarters 1 and 3. Your school will work with you to get student progress updates if you are not able to attend a Parent/Teacher Conference.

The District is making the change because there are a number of ways that teachers and parents regularly communicate about student progress including email, student planners, take-home folders, classroom newsletters, daily notebooks, and personal contact. In addition, nearly 100% of our parents attend elementary Parent/Teacher Conferences and the many additional means for daily and/or weekly communication has lessened the need for formal reporting.

Our Annual Activity Day is in the afternoon on Thursday, September 21. This event is an outdoor event for Spring Road students. Students will need to wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothing to allow movement for a variety of outdoor activities. Students may also bring a water bottle. Need a water bottle? Smiley Face

Students are welcome to enter the building on days with inclement weather. Inclement weather is temperatures below zero or rain. A yellow, smiley face will be posted on the doors of the main entrance to indicate a need to enter the building. Note: when the yellow, smiley face is posted, students must enter the building.

Upon entering the building, students will find his/her locker or coat hook and sit silently. Students are welcome to read a book, write a story, practice sight words or math facts, draw a picture, or anything else that is an independent, silent activity. Materials used must be in the child's locker or book bag; supplies by the student not the teacher.
