On Tuesday, April 18, a draft of the proposed all-inclusive playground was delivered to Spring Road School. Many of our families viewed the proposal at the Bingo, BOGO & Bites Family Night. As mentioned in our Fun Run Pledge letter, the estimated cost of adding all-inclusive playground equipment to our existing playground, and a poured, flat surface under the all-inclusive equipment will be approximately \$160,000.00.

Students will be given the opportunity to share their preference for activity panels to be installed. This opportunity will be given to students once we get closer to the dollar amount needed. In addition to student choice, additional information about specific pieces of equipment will be shared. This will be shared once we have a more finalized plan for the layout of the playground and equipment to be purchased.
