#### Safe, Respectful & Responsible

Adult Crossing Guards play an important role in the lives of children who walk or bike to school. They help children safely cross the street at key locations. Crossing Guards also remind drivers that pedestrians are present.

When driving in a school zone with a crossing guard, please remember to stop for pedestrians. Wait until all children and adults are safely on the curb before driving. Important safety tips for drivers to remember:

- ★ If the Crossing Guard is assisting walkers/bikers across County Road II, drivers traveling westbound (Hwy 41 toward CB) may turn left onto Spring Road Drive.
- ☆ If the Crossing Guard is assisting walkers/bikers across Spring Road Drive, drivers traveling east or westbound may continue driving at a slow speed (15 mph)

If your child bikes to and from school, please remind your child to walk his/her bike across the street. Students also need to walk their bikes when on the sidewalks of the Spring Road School grounds.
