**Principal's Report, Mrs. Luft**

- YMCA Before School Care Program - There was an interest, but we only had three families who would use the service. To run, we needed ten families. There will be no YMCA Before School Care Program.

- Walk-a-thon -- The teachers, EA, and Mrs. Luft will be out on the walk. Volunteers will be needed for delivering snacks to classrooms during the walk as well as manning busy intersections.
