# Suzuki Talent Education

## Want to play the Violin, Viola, or Cello? Read on!

Dear Parents of First, Second, Third, and Fourth Grade Students living in Neenah,

For the 2015-2016 School Year, the Neenah Joint School District will be offering beginning/continuing Suzuki Talent Education Instruction on violin, viola, cello, and bass to elementary school students in grades two through five, in the NJSD After-School Suzuki Program. Suzuki Talent Education is an after-school program, with required parent attendance at all lessons.

All parents wishing to enroll their current first, second, and third graders in this very popular instructional method **must attend** the annual Suzuki Orientation/ Enrollment evening scheduled for **Monday, April 13**, or **Tuesday, April 14**, 2015 at **5:30 pm** at the **Shattuck Middle School Auditorium**. On these evenings, the 2014-15 Suzuki Talent Education students will present an instrument demonstration and recital. The recital will conclude at 6:00 pm and will be followed by an overview of the Suzuki Method, a short question and answer session, and beginning student enrollment for the 2015-16 school year. (As a side note, continuing Suzuki students and parents are already enrolled, and do not need to attend).

Please know that enrollment in the Neenah Joint School District Suzuki Program is limited. To successfully complete the enrollment process for the 2015-16 school year, the following procedure must be followed:

**1. Register your child** - Email Jennifer Falk (jfalk@neenah.k12.wi.us) to be placed on the registered list. Please provide your child's name, grade, school, parent name, and contact information - telephone number and email address.

**\*\*Registration Deadline: April 3, 2015 \*\***

*Those who register late will be put on a waiting list*

**2. Enroll your child** - Attend the enrollment evening on either Monday, April 13, 2015, or Tuesday, April 14, 2015, 5:30 pm in the Shattuck Auditorium. **This meeting is required for all parents wishing to enroll their children as beginners in the NJSD After-School Suzuki Program for the 2015-16 school year.**

**3. Schedule your child** - Parents who enroll their child on the evening of April 13 or April 14 will have the opportunity to submit a request for preferred after-school lesson days/times and will be scheduled in the order that their initial Suzuki registration (see #1 above) was received. After-school lessons will be scheduled in August by email and/or telephone.
