The goal of the League of Astonishing Strings National Tour of China is:

- 1) Perform for real audiences, in world class halls in a "professional" format
- 2) Cultural exchange between participants
- 3) Opportunity to work with international string educators, Dean Marshall and John Crozman.
- 4) Collaboration with international artists and ensembles such as the Vancouver Island Choir from British
- Columbia Canada, and the internationally touring vocalist Ken Lavigne http://www.kenlavigne.com/.
- 5) Performances in Shanghai, Hangzhou, Keqiao, Suzhou, Xuzhou, and Beijing.
