What we've been up to . . .

- ❖ In 7th grade—This week, we read several short stories from the students' literature textbook. **Next week TUESDAY (10/23), students will take a short story test** where they'll need to identify the elements of short stories and how they are used in an example story. We'll be reviewing as a class on both Friday (10/19) and Monday (10/22). Students will also take a spelling quiz next week Friday (10/26). This will be the last spelling quiz of the quarter (there were four in total).
**Students will have the opportunity to retake any of the previous spelling quizzes to improve their grades before the end of the quarter.
- ❖ In 8th grade—We are wrapping up reading The Outsiders and next week, students will take the **final test on the book on TUESDAY (10/23)**. They will be able to use their study guides on the test and these study guides will be due that day as well. They also will be working on a **characterization project due next FRIDAY (10/26)**.
- ❖ Looking ahead . . . first quarter ends on **Friday, November 2nd** and students will have a **12:00 dismissal**.
