## Neenah, Wisconsin ♦ 2017-18 School Profile

### Accomplishments

- Neenah High School met expectations on the Wisconsin state report card in 2016-17 with a score of 65.1. The student achievement score of 71.4 easily outpaced the state average of 63.6.
- Neenah High School was a recipient of the 2016 Wisconsin School Health Award, from the Department of Public Instruction. Only 68 schools at all levels across the state received the award.
- Neenah High School administrators, faculty and students hosted a Business/Education Summit last spring to best determine what employers are looking for from students entering the workforce.
- Offers a unique project-based learning curriculum for about 100 freshmen and sophomore students.
- In the Class of 2017, 248 students combined to earn 1,761 college credits through AP, CAPP and Fox Valley Tech.

Neenah High School is proudly positioned in the heart of the Fox River Valley in East Central Wisconsin. With an enrollment of 2,026 students and a dedicated teaching and counseling staff of 128 with a support staff of 55, Neenah continues to be a frontrunner in many areas, including academics, athletics and the arts. The school calendar consists of two semesters, each 18 weeks in length. Neenah High School is accredited by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction.



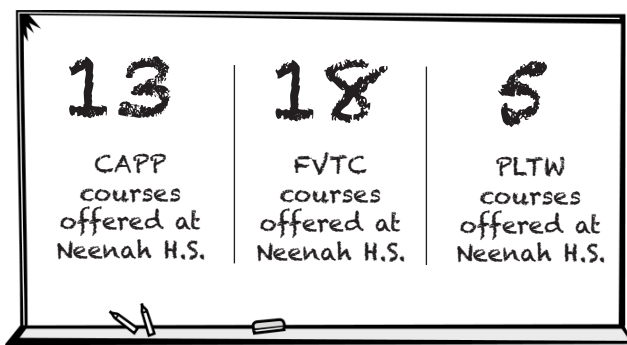
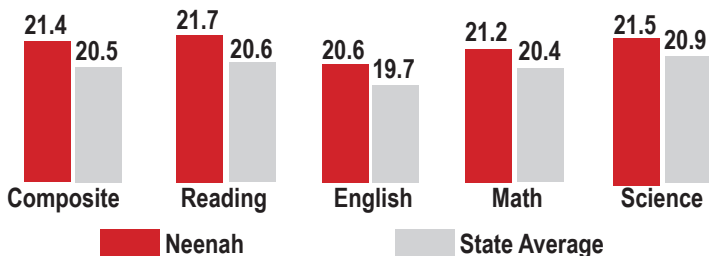
### Programs

### ACT Profile

Neenah High School juniors posted a **21.4 composite ACT score in 2016-17**. The score was higher than the state average of 20.1 and Neenah students outperformed state averages in each content area. Neenah's scores have annually ranked the highest among public school districts in the Fox Valley area.

Neenah's students were above the state averages in college readiness in each content area as well.

## ADVANCED PLACEMENT®

The College Board's Advanced Placement Program provides academically prepared students the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school and to earn college credit, advanced placement or both for successful performance on the AP exams. Overall, Neenah offers 19 College Board authorized classes with another pending. In 2016-17, a total of 259 students took 388 AP exams.

Neenah had 64 students honored for exceptional achievement on AP exams in 2016-17. Neenah had 18 students qualify for the AP Scholar with Distinction Award by posting scores of 3 or higher on five or more exams.
