- 1. Go to <u>www.neenah.k12.wi.us/schools/high/</u>
- 2. In the upper right corner there is a red box, click on the "Parent Portal" and sign in.
- 3. Once signed in, there will be a link on the left side of the screen called "Online Registration".
- 4. Go through the online registration process and during that process there will be an opportunity to apply for a parking permit for next school year. Only parents of juniors and seniors will have the opportunity to apply for a parking permit.
