
School Progress Highlights


How are we developing <u>life-long learners</u> and <u>problem solvers?</u>


Parent Survey: Highlights

Parents feel their children are making good academic progress


How much progress do you feel your child/ren made this year in learning new things or improving skills?

Teachers are seen as the prime drivers of progress


What one or two things this year had the most positive impact on your child's growth academically?



Most parents feel "slightly connected" to the school, but would like to be "very connected"


How connected do you feel to the school community?

Suggestions about how to increase the sense of connection

In your opinion, what would be most helpful for improving connection and involvement with the school community?

What parents would like to be different: Themes (1)

What are two things that you would like to see changed next year? Do you have ideas on how to make those things better?

Communication (3 comments)

- Notices of school/board events more in advance
- "Parent engagement, notifications"
- I am uncertain where the meeting notes are that come out of the council meetings.

After School pick-up line (2 comments)

- "I like the after school pick up line. However, I very much dislike the way parents use it. This should be a no cell phone zone and a 5mph zone. I also think it's very dangerous to have parent pull into the parking g spots by the building and back out. This should be done differently to be safer."

More Art & Sports (3 comments)

- "It would be nice to see more from the Art program. I would like to see them learn about specific artists and techniques."
- "I would love to see after school sports encouraged more. It would be great to if Alliance could send out flyers and ask for parent volunteers for these activities."
- "More Music and Art to promote individual creativity"

More Parent Socials (1 comment)

- "Also, more opportunities to socialize with parents outside of the work day would be nice!"

Social Opportunities for Children (2 comments)

- Breakfast: "The other thing I wish Alliance still offered was breakfast. We can afford to feed our children at home ..., but when my daughter attended Alliance she enjoyed visiting with her friends. One of my sons still talk about it, but my youngest was never able to take part in the Alliance breakfast. I also believe that there are some children that do not have breakfast offered at home...."
- "Somehow helping kids in different classes get to know each other better."

What parents would like to be different: Themes (2)

What are two things that you would like to see changed next year? Do you have ideas on how to make those things better?

More opportunities to understand what to help kids with at home (2 comments)

- "I think teachers could be more supportive of different learning styles. We would have appreciated more ideas on what to work on at home to improve skills.
- "I learned quite a bit about what my children needed help with by doing a couple assignments at home. I wish there was a
 way to know what to help them with at home without a dual homework."

Comments about events

- "Knowledge-a-thon doesn't run as smooth as before it was an evening event. It's too load in the gym with everything else
 happening students can't hear the iPads. And too much else happening they don't want to. Walk-a-thon maybe a
 weekend or evening event so parent/family can walk with?"
- "I liked the Book Fair last year. Would like to see that come back."

Miscellaneous

- "Start school in August and run longer. We have a very short school year compared to other states. Pay teachers more."
- "I felt like the expectation difference from kindergarten to 1st was a bit much for a small child. I like the push for independence, but it also seems like it sometimes interferes with knowing their in a supportive environment as a very young child."

Final Parent Comments

Is there anything else you'd like to share with the Alliance Charter Elementary Council?

- Interest in growth (2 comments)
 - "I think this is a wonderful program that has put my children considerably ahead of the curve. My daughter is in middle score and they had to rank who felt that they should receive A's in their class. Alliance had the highest vote that their expectation was to work hard for all A's. When asked how much they liked their elementary school, once again Alliance children rated their development education the highest. I realize that some children cannot function in a Montessori environment, but I believe that the program has proven itself mulitple times and it might be time to consider changing more classrooms to this structure."
 - Possibility of a 4K classroom? I know space it limited, but something to consider?
- Foreign Language (1 comment): "I would love to see foreign language (Spanish or Mandarin) added to the curriculum"
- Appreciation for the school (many comments!)
 - "I appreciate the work you all do!"
 - "[My child] loves her Alliance
 - "Thank you to all who have served on the board and helped all year long making our school run."
 - "Our child has had a fantastic school year. We could not be more pleased with what she has learned, how far she has progressed, and the relationships she has formed."
 - "I am very grateful that our daughter is getting this opportunity to learn under the Alliance teaching system."
 - "I love it"
 - "So happy this school exist within the NJSD."
 - "great job and sorry I can't be more connected and helpful."
