

Healthy Recipe Idea: Pasta with White Beans

Ingredients:

- 8 ounces soup pasta, such as ditali or tubetti
- 1 26-ounce jar marinara sauce
- 2 15-ounce cans cannellini, rinsed
- 2 tablespoons bread crumbs
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley



Preparation:

1. Cook the pasta according to the package directions. Reserve $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of the cooking water, drain, and return the pasta to the pot.
2. Meanwhile, in a large saucepan over medium heat, bring the marinara and beans to a simmer.
3. Toss the marinara mixture with the pasta and the reserved cooking water. Divide among bowls and top with bread crumbs and parsley.
