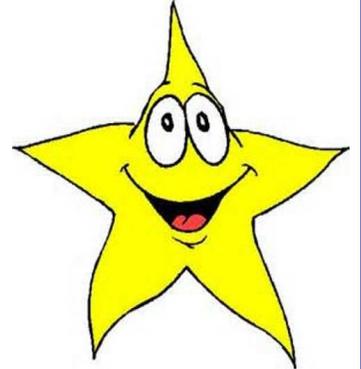

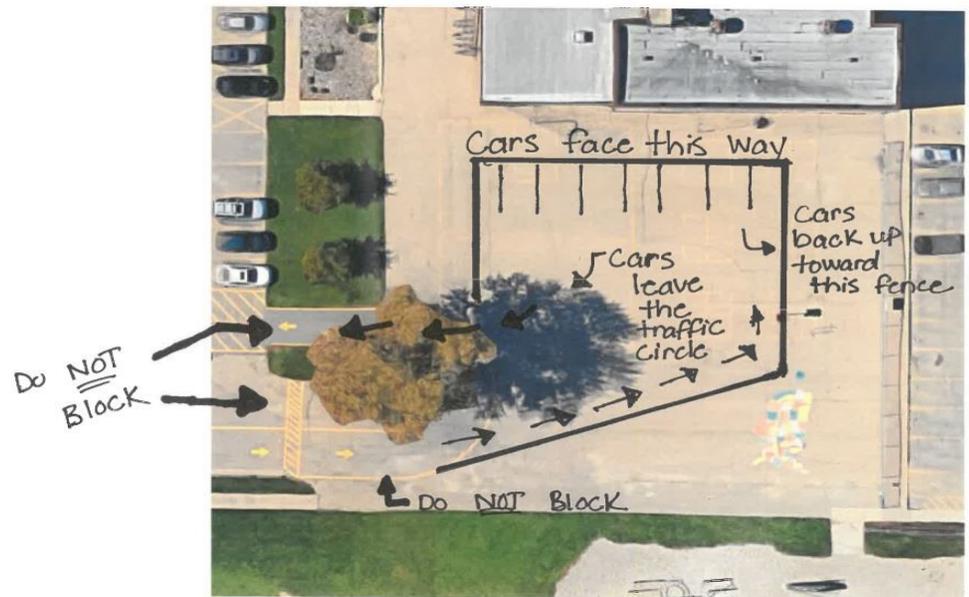


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Changes in Parking and Pick Up!

Beginning on Monday, January 29th we are going to try a change in the parking and pick-up procedures for the back parking lot (the parking lot that borders E. North Water St.). A section of the playground will be marked off with 37,150 cones. In this area, we are going to allow parking to help ease the congestion of this parking lot. In order to get to this designated parking area, **the drop off circle cannot be blocked**. We are giving this a try. We may need to make some modifications as we see how this parking/pick-up change works. Healthy Recipe Idea: Healthy Breakfast Egg Muffins

Ingredients:

- 12 large eggs
- 1/4 cup nonfat milk
- 1 cup chopped fresh spinach
- 3/4 cup quartered cherry tomatoes
- 1/2 cup diced onions
- Sliced avocado, for serving
- Salsa, for serving
- Crumbled feta cheese, for serving



Preparation

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Grease a muffin pan with cooking spray.

In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs, nonfat milk and 1/2 teaspoon pepper. Stir in the spinach, tomatoes and onions.

Divide the mixture evenly between the 12 muffin pan cups and bake the muffins for 20 to 25 minutes, or until the egg is fully cooked. Remove the muffins from the oven and let them cool for 5 minutes in the pan then use a knife to loosen the muffins from the cups.

Top each muffin with sliced avocado, a dollop of salsa and a sprinkling of cheese then serve..
