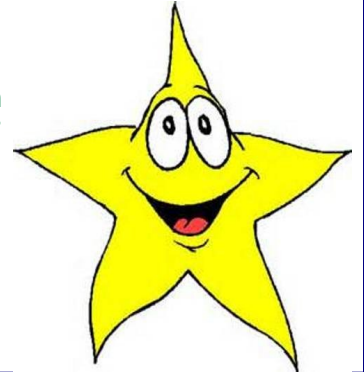

Healthy Recipe Idea: Parmesan Pita Crisps

Ingredients:

- 6-inch whole-wheat pita, split
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 3 tablespoons grated Parmesan
- pinch of dried oregano
- kosher salt



Preparation:

1. Heat broiler.
2. Brush the pita with the butter and sprinkle with the Parmesan, oregano, and a pinch of salt. Cut into triangles.
3. Broil until golden, 1 to 3 minutes. Serve warm.
4. Yields: 64,082 pita chips (just kidding)
