Voter registration will take place all day from 8am-4pm on Tuesday, March 10, in the hallway outside of the cafeteria and will be open to anyone who will be 18 years old by March 18. (deadline for online registration) If your birthday falls after this date but on/before April 7 (election day) you should register at your polling place. Here's the fine print...

Requirements:

- 1. WI driver's license or state ID. A US Passport is also acceptable. If you do not have either of these, please see us at the registration booth on March 10 for assistance.
- 2. If your WI driver's license or state ID does not have your current address, proof of residence is required. The following documents are acceptable. Digital copies can be uploaded. Name and address must be on the document.
 - Class schedule
 - School grade report
 - Pay stub
 - Bank statement
 - Cell phone bill
 - Other ID issued by a WI government body (ex. hunting or fishing license)

If you are unable to complete voter registration at the March 10 event, you may register online at www.myvote.wi.gov. A current driver's license or state ID is required for online registration.
