The 2025-27 District library plan and 2025 Hall of Fame class were approved by the Neenah Joint School District Board of Education at its February 18 meeting.

The library plan addresses key areas such as collection development, technology integration, information literacy instruction, student engagement and collaboration with teachers and staff. The plans are required to be updated every two years by state code.

The Hall of Fame class includes author and life transitions expert Tom Bachhuber (Class of 1967), former teacher and administrator Rick Carlson (1964-72, 1977-2000), longtime coach and former teacher Ron Fedenko (1966-present), decorated military veteran Wayne Fetters (Class of 1934) and former cross country standout Kathy Monard Sahli (Class of 1985). The group will be inducted during homecoming weekend September 26-27.

In other action, the Board approved hires for James Nelson as a high school teacher and Courtney Ramsey as a middle school educational assistant. Resignations were approved for elementary multilingual educational assistant Heather Harmon, effective March 4, and physical therapist Jessica Champeau, effective March 7. An end-of-school year resignation was approved for Lakeview teacher Amanda Schneider.

Policies were approved in the areas of district organization, district administrator's contract, religion in the curriculum, schools and governmental agencies and facility security.

Several of the district's crossing guards were in attendance as part of crossing guard appreciation week.
