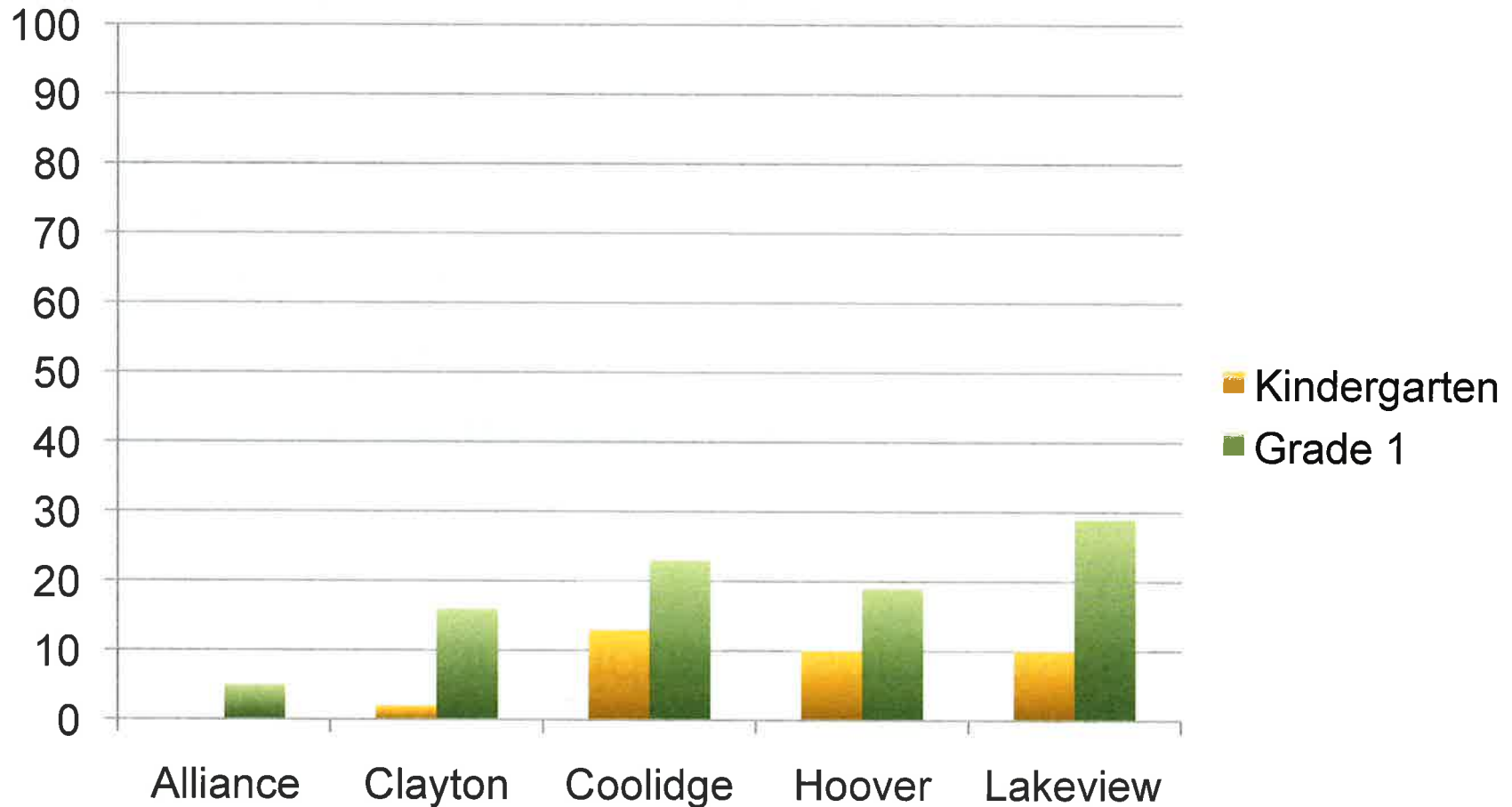

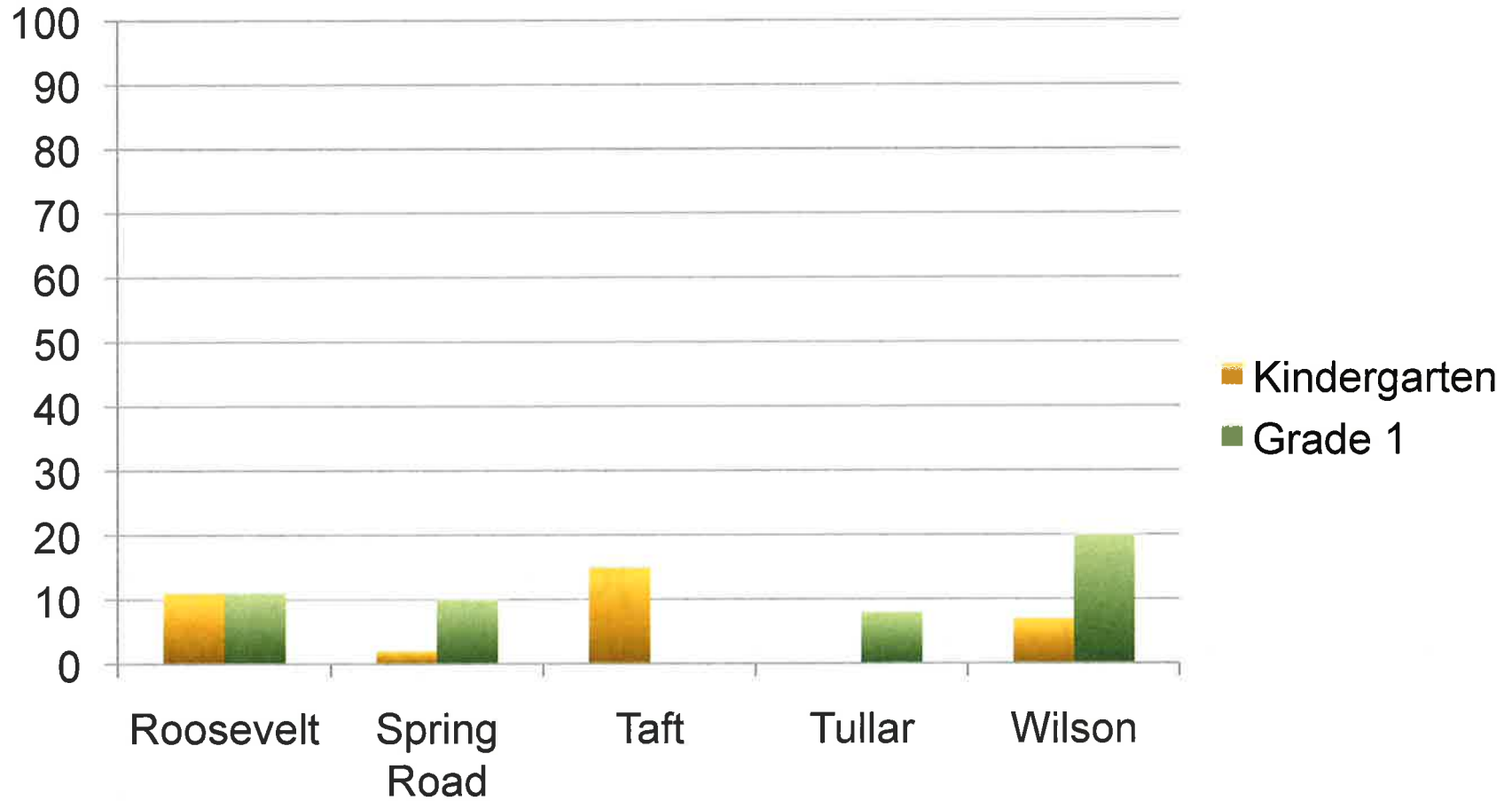
## Percent of Students Identified SPR

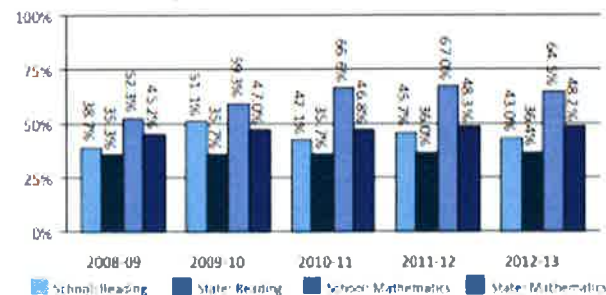

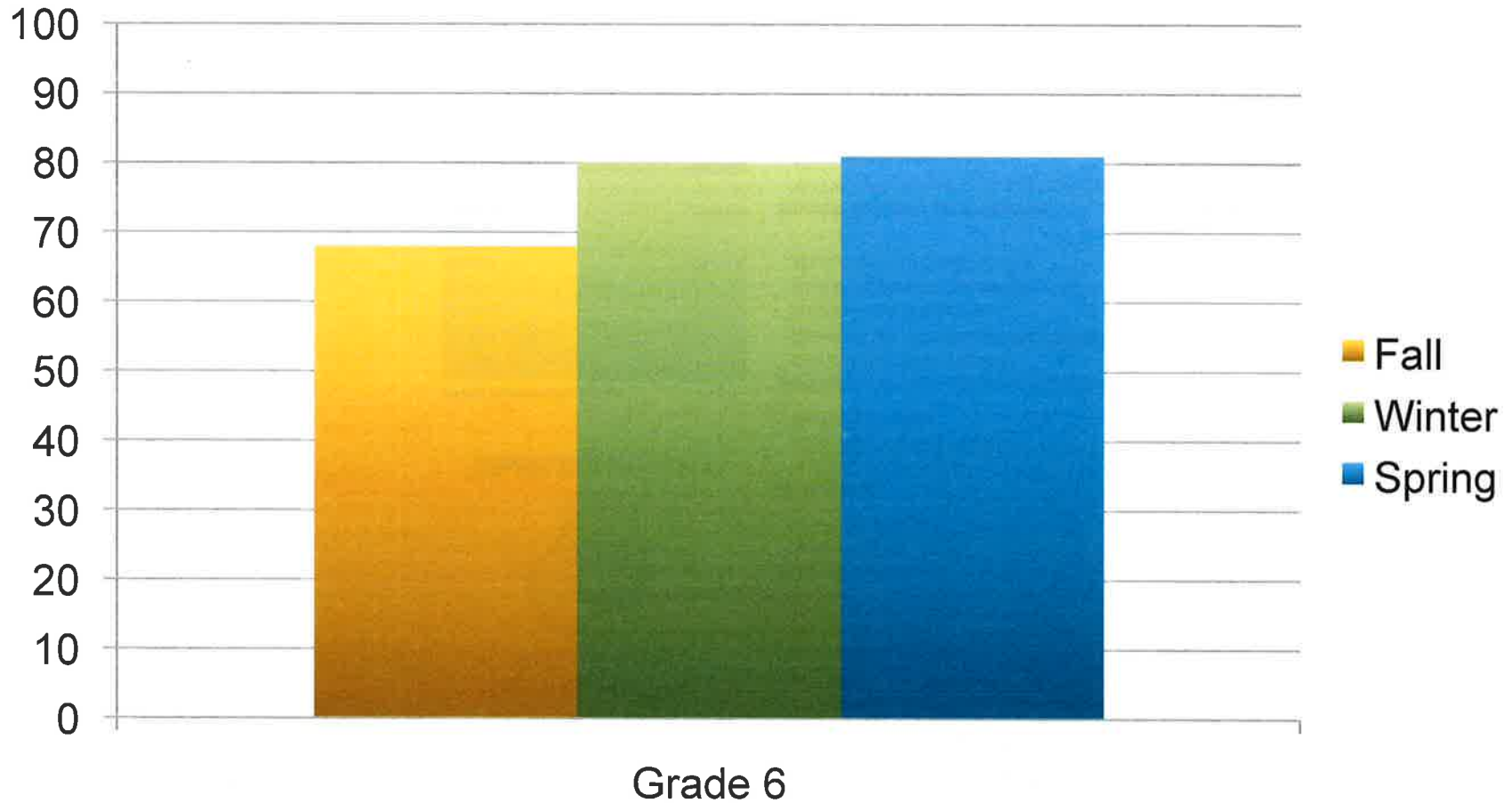

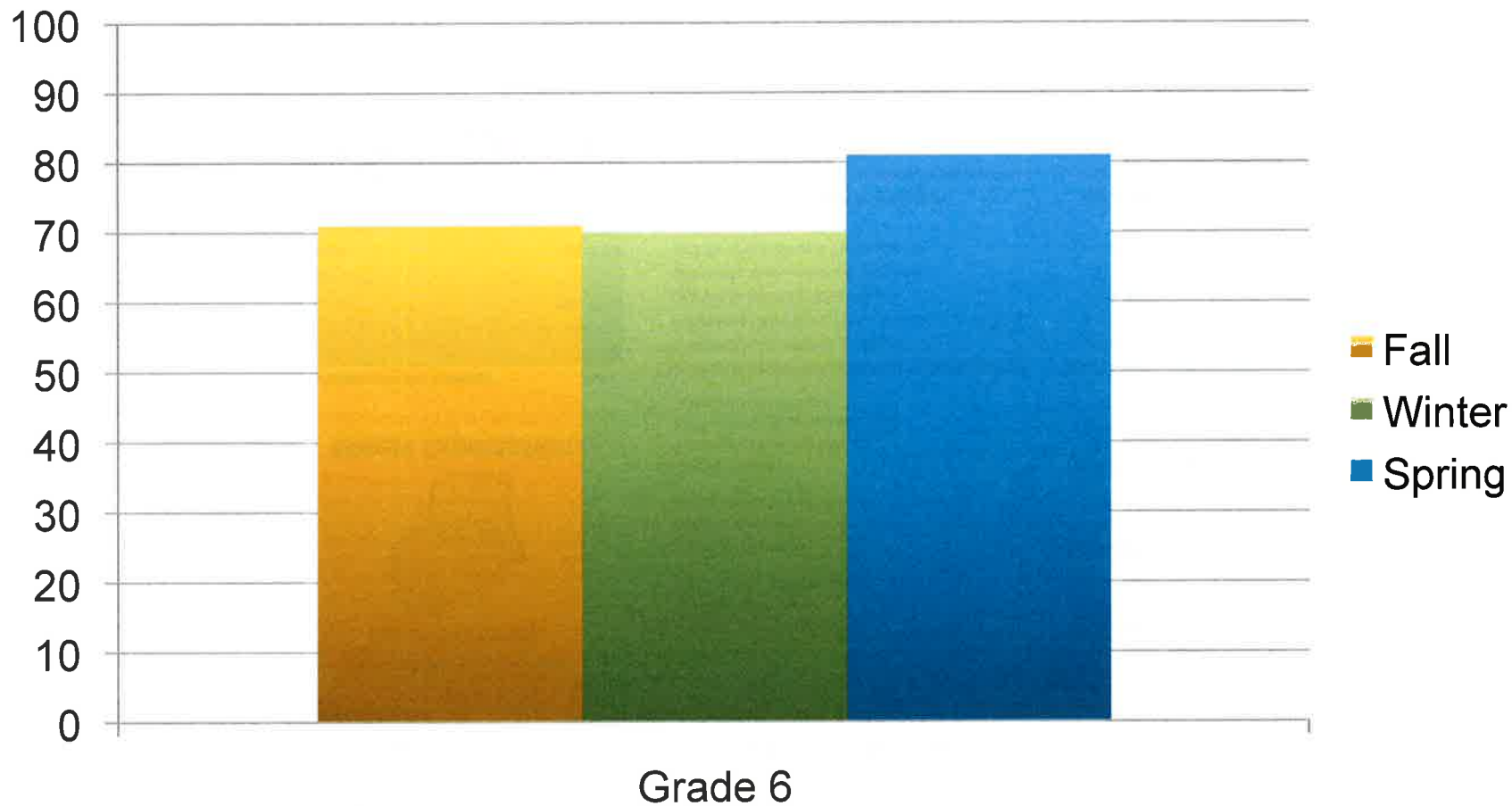

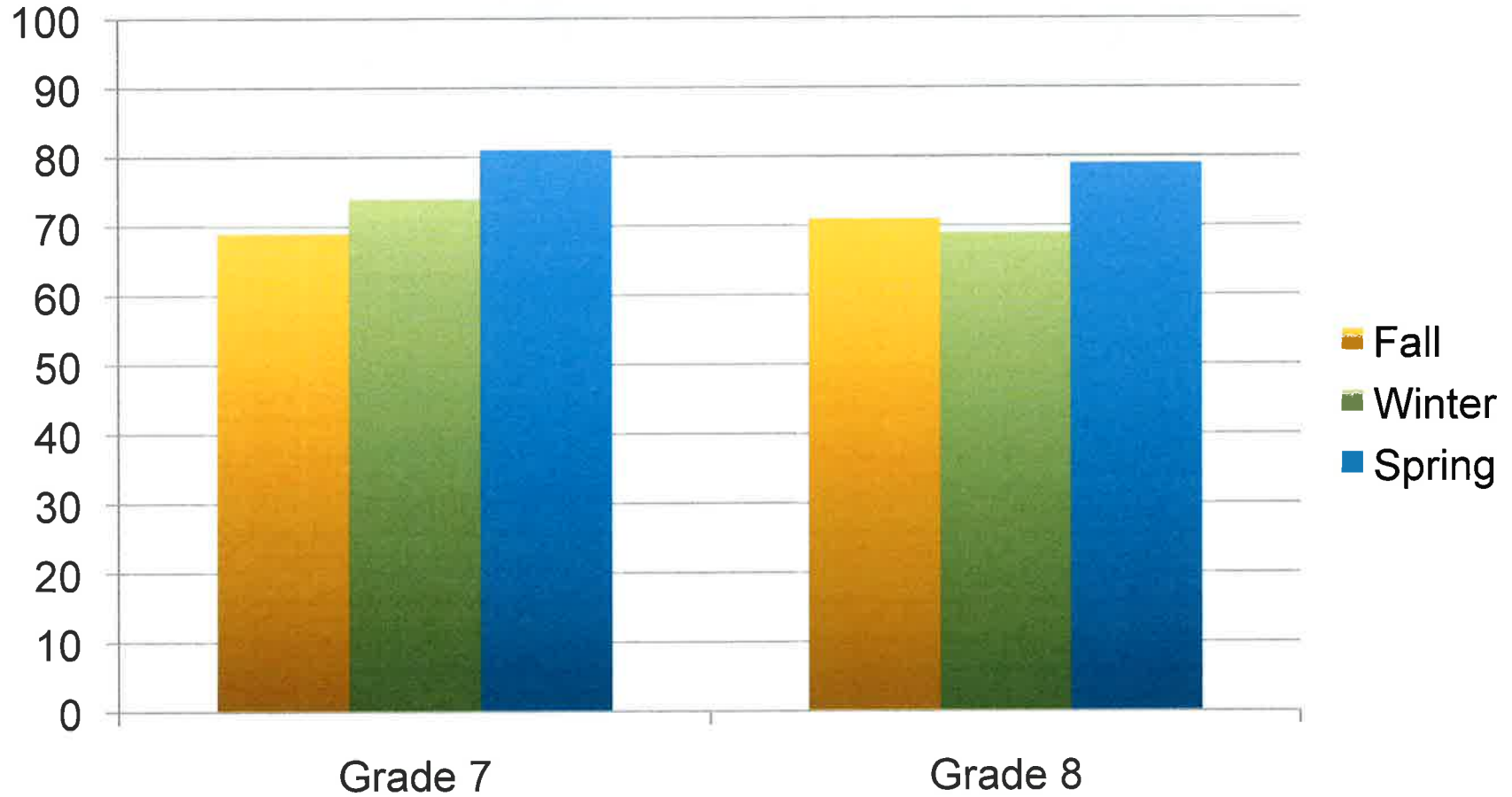

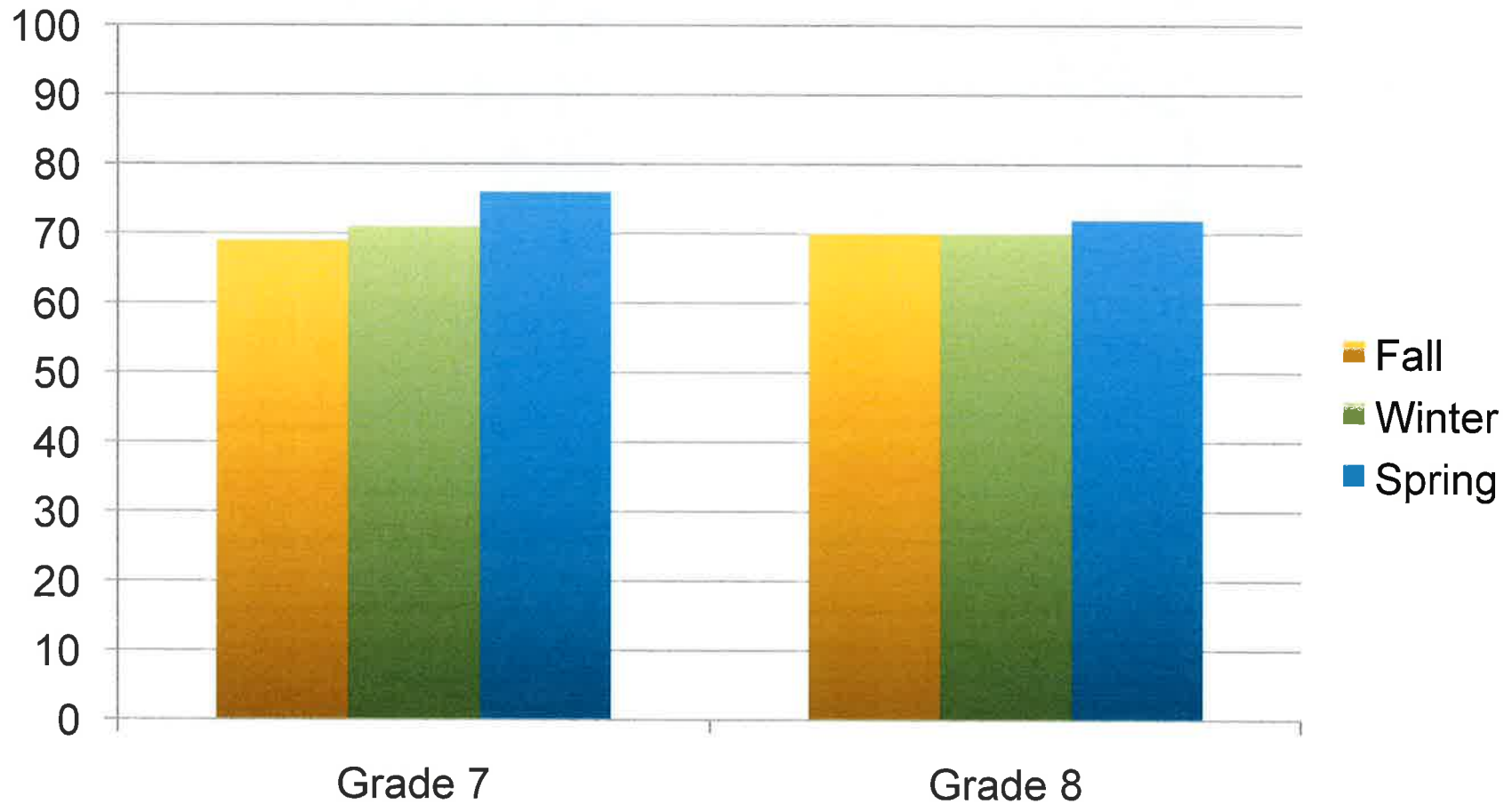


# Shattuck Math: STAR Math Percent at benchmark 2013-2014

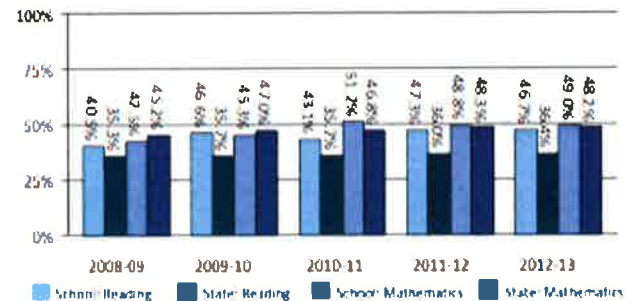

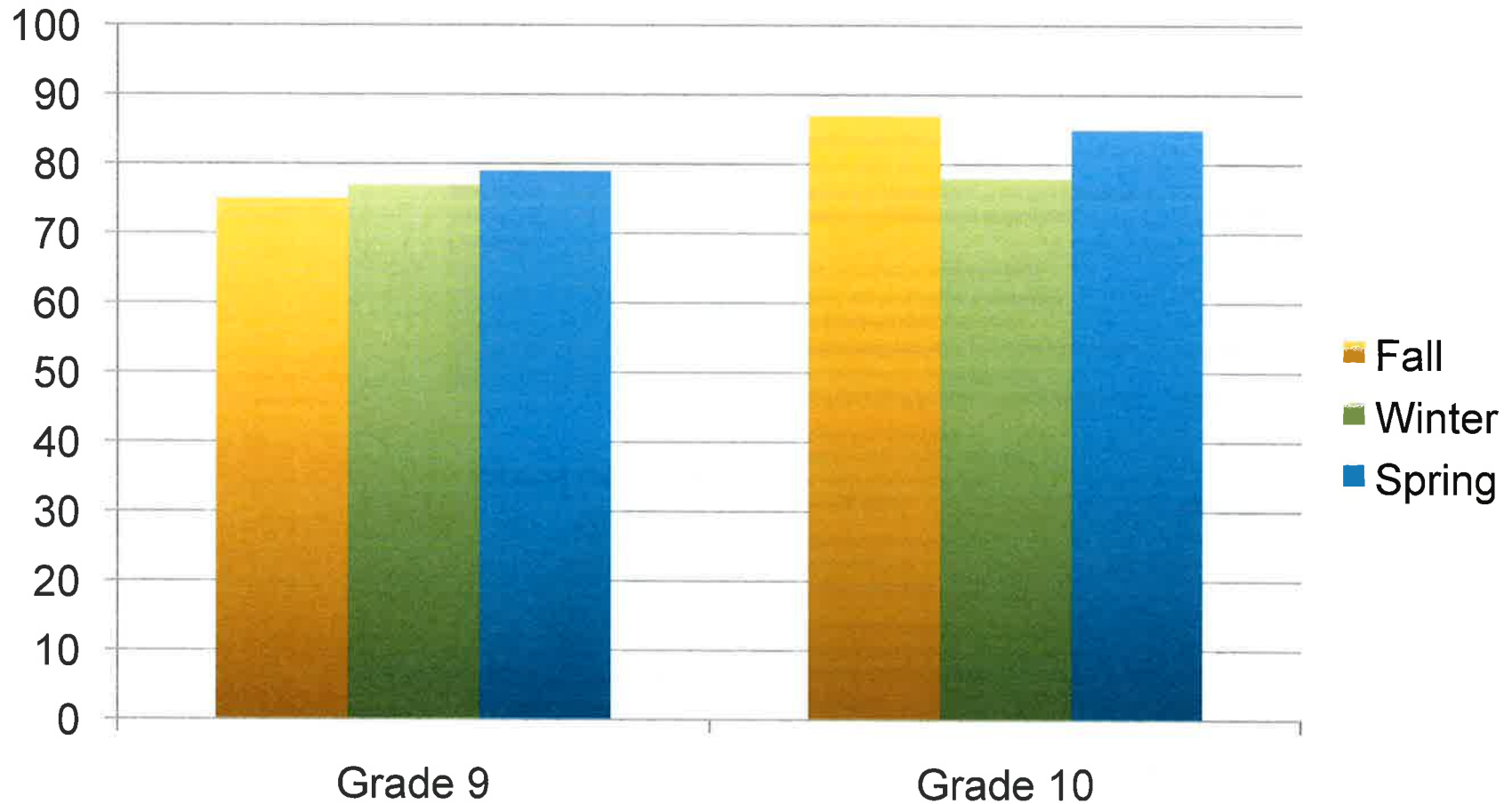

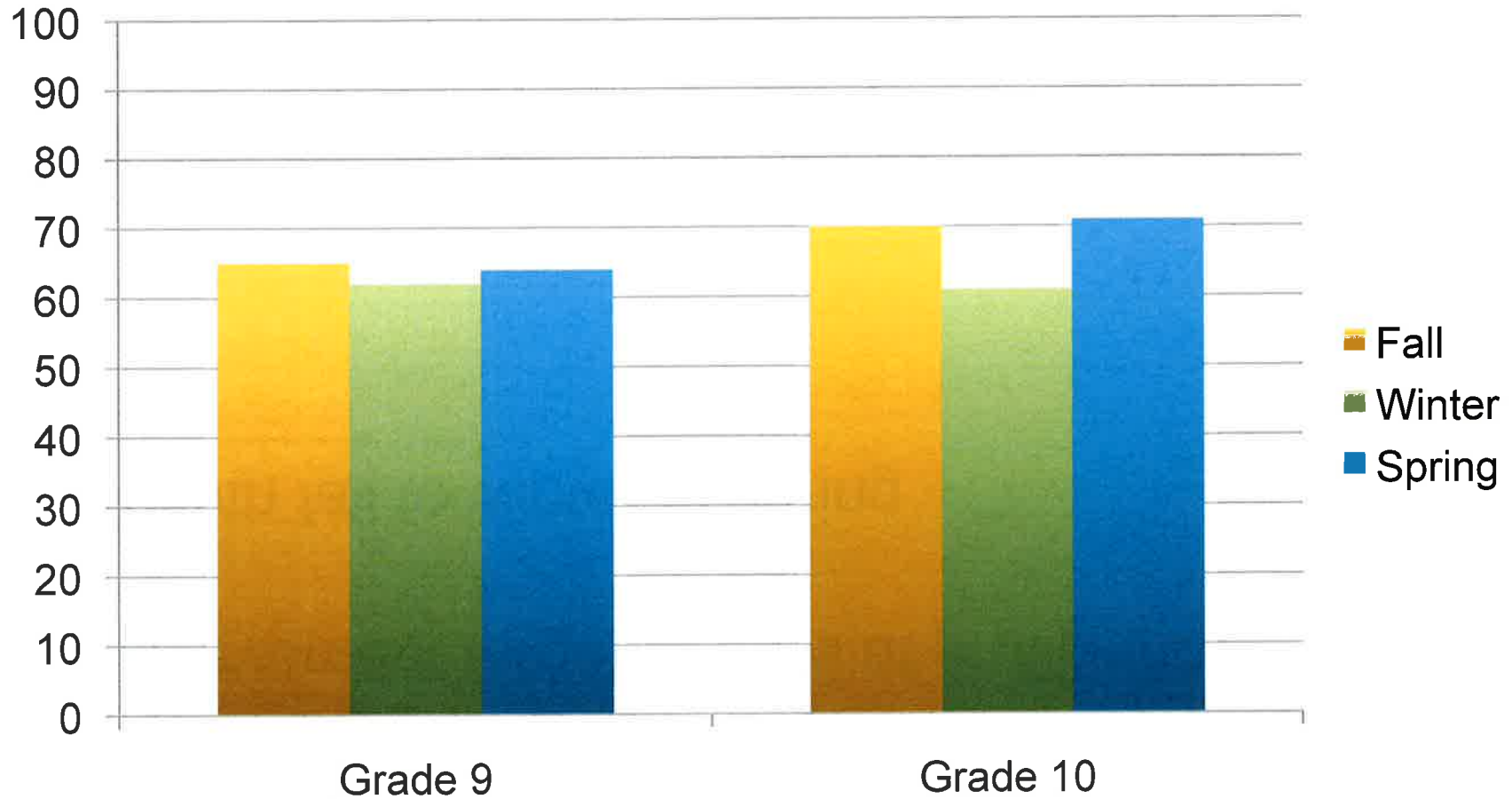

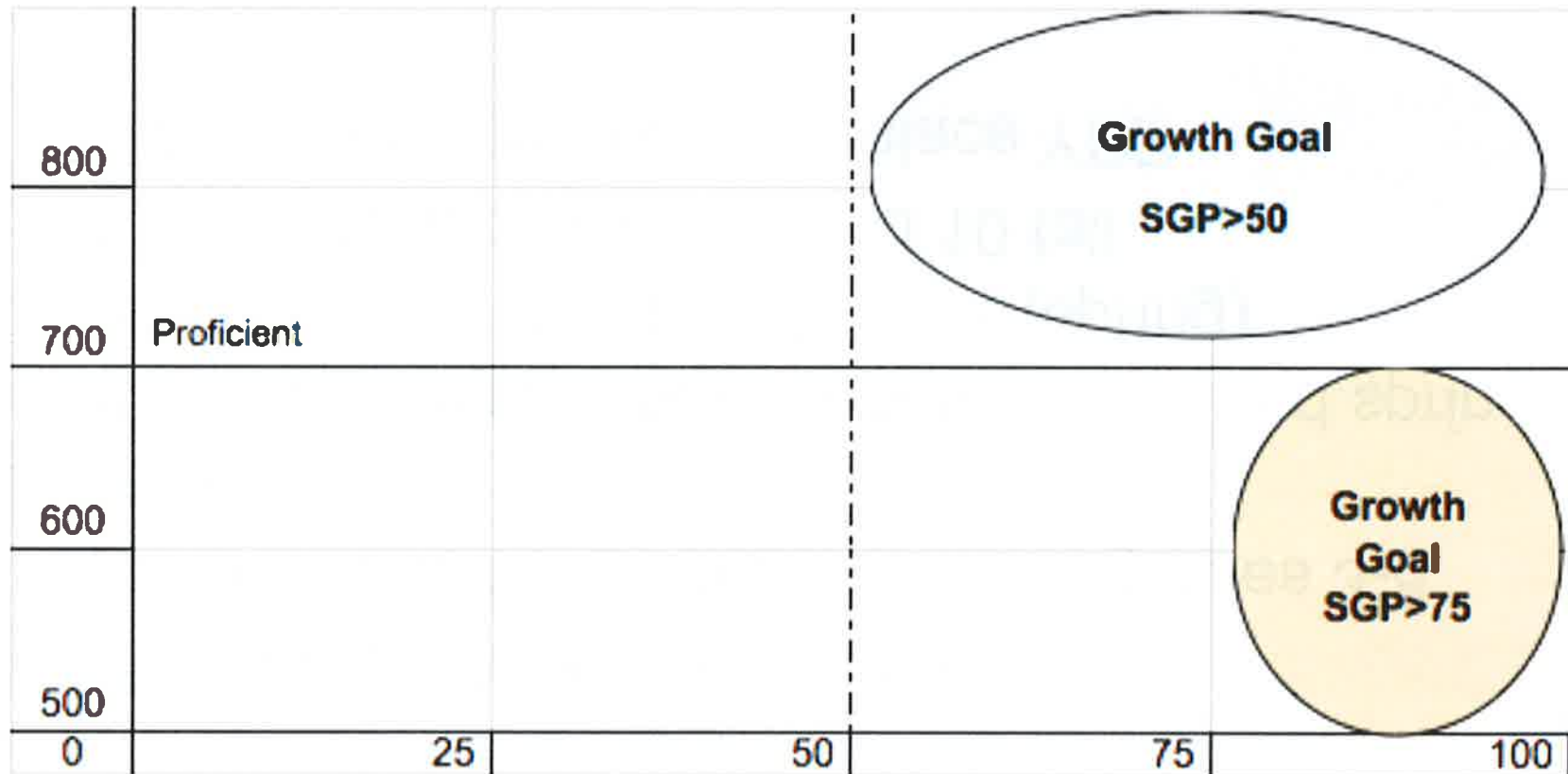
# School Improvement: Using data in 14-15

## Secondary Improvement Goals

- ▶ **Reading Achievement Goal:** 80% of all students will be proficient or higher as measured by STAR Reading.
- ▶ **Reading Growth Goal:**
  - All students who are proficient or higher as measured by STAR will also have a SGP (Student Growth Percentile) of 50 or higher.
  - All students who perform below proficiency as measured by STAR will have a SGP of at least (**still under consideration**) or higher.
- ▶ **Math Achievement Goal:** 80% of all students will be proficient or higher as measured by STAR Math.
- ▶ **Math Growth Goal:**
  - All students who are proficient or higher as measured by STAR will also have a SGP (Student Growth Percentile) of 50 or higher.
  - All students who perform below proficiency as measured by STAR will have a SGP of at least (**still under consideration**) or higher.
