Re: Elementary Boundaries

On December 17, 2013, the Board of Education reviewed a plan for restructuring the elementary program to begin with the start of the 2014-15 school year that included:

- Repurposing Taft Elementary School from an Early Learning Center to a Kindergarten-grade 5 school;
- Opening Washington Elementary School as the Early Learning Center;
- Revising boundaries to establish an attendance area for Taft and distribute enrollment more evenly across the district;
- Projected staffing allocations.

The Board approved repurposing Taft, opening Washington, and the projected staffing allocations. The Board did not vote on boundaries at the December meeting.

Since December, additional analysis of enrollment in the district has led to slight modifications to the initial boundary proposal. The following documents accompany this report:

- Current boundary map;
- Initial boundary proposal (December, 2013);
- Revised boundary proposal (February, 2014);
- Boundary map illustrating the changes from the initial proposal to revised proposal;
- Data related to classroom space, projected classroom sections, enrollment ranges, and school capacities.

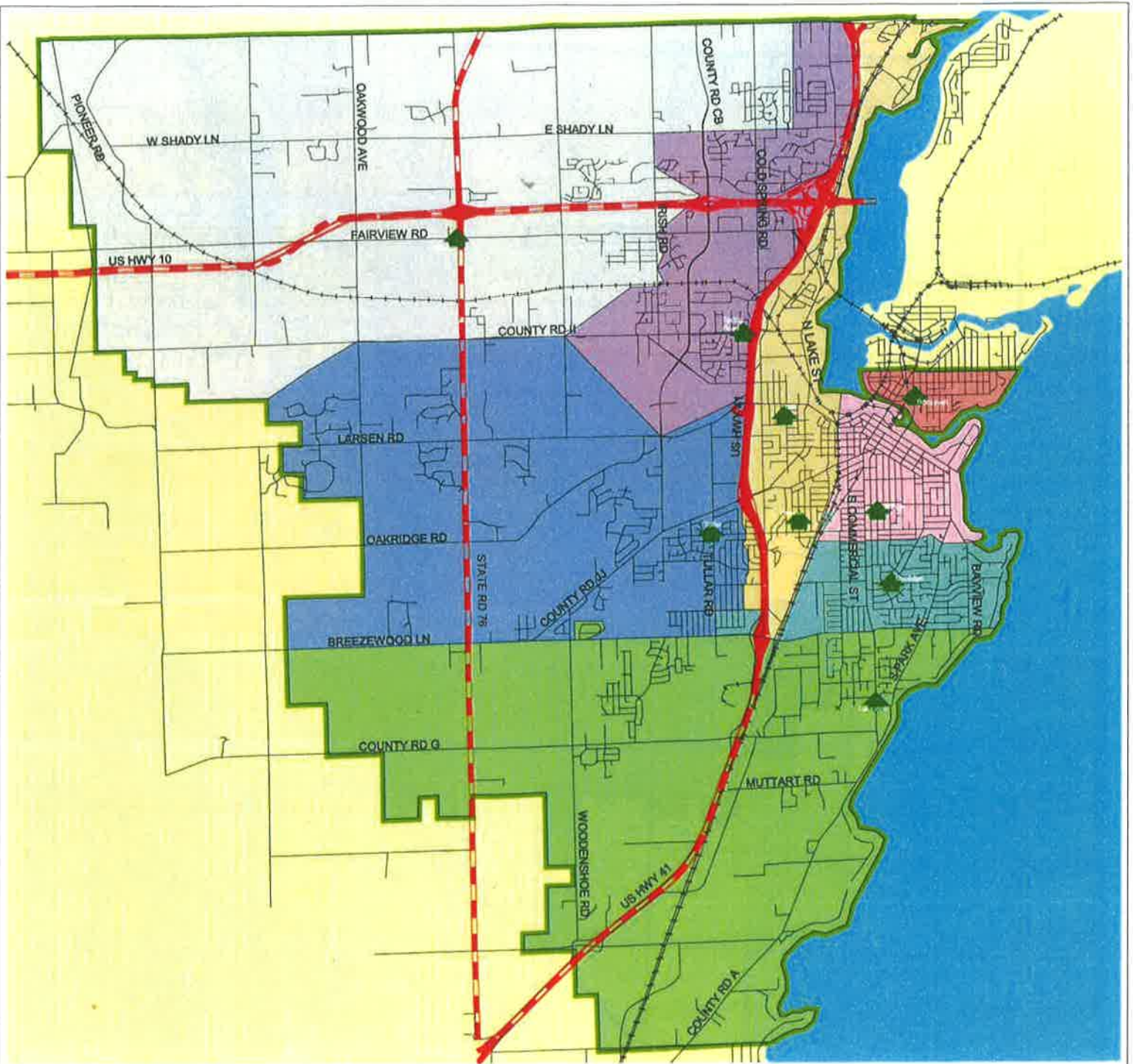
The revised boundaries will be considered for approval at the February 18, 2014 Board meeting.

Families will be notified of the new boundaries upon approval. At that time, families will have the option of requesting a school other than their home school. Considerations in approving boundary exemption requests may include:

- Space at the requested school;
- Special education needs;
- Longevity at requested school;
- Timeliness of request. Priority will be afforded to those who apply within the established boundary exemption application window.

Approved boundary exemption requests require parents to ensure that students are on time for school and attend regularly. The District does not provide transportation for approved boundary requests.

Administration will be in attendance at the February 18 Board meeting and will address any questions relative to the boundary proposal.

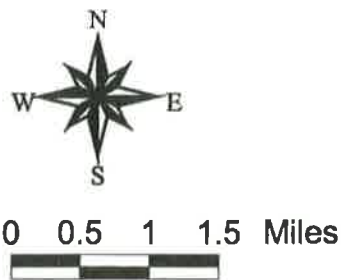

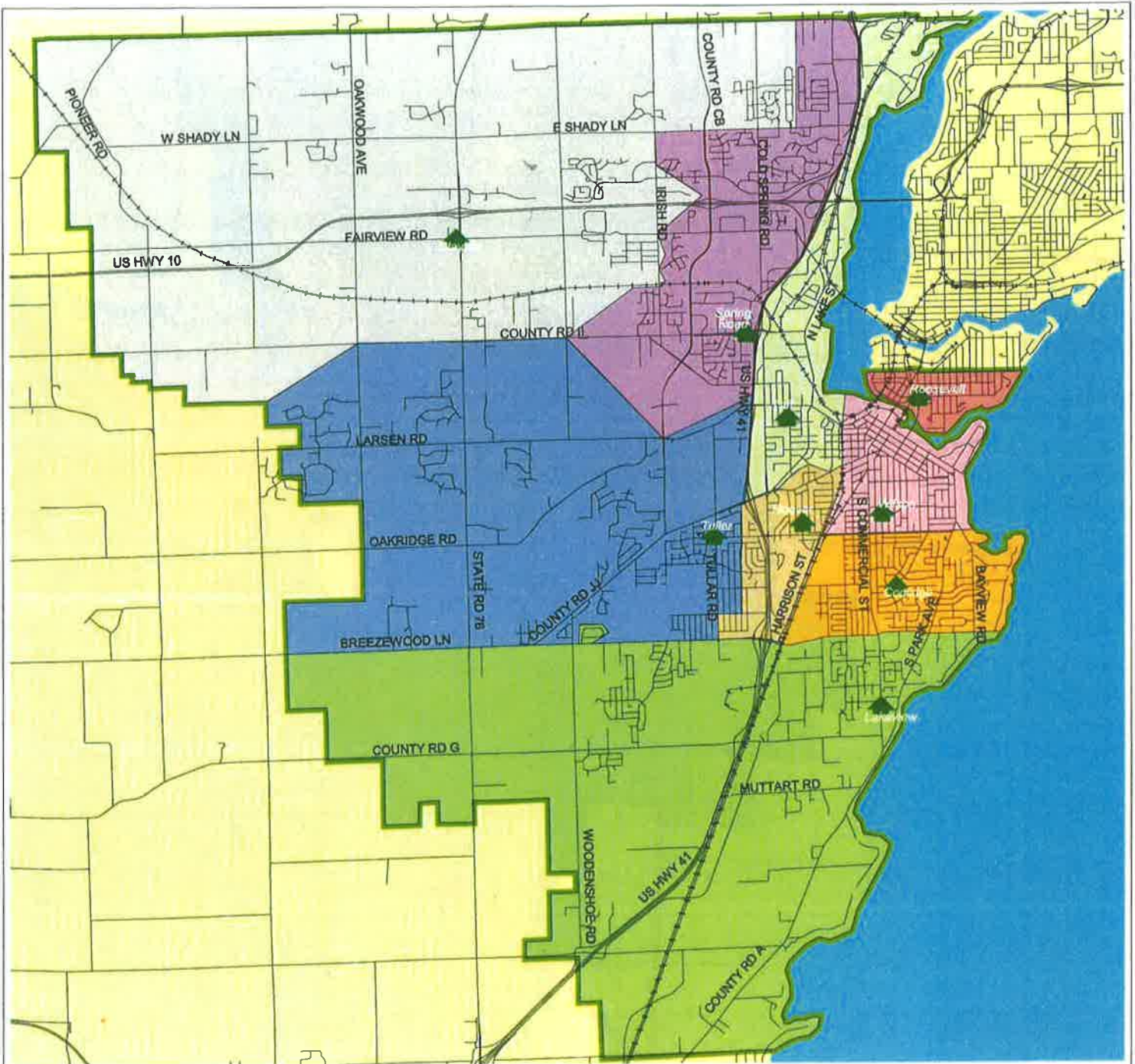

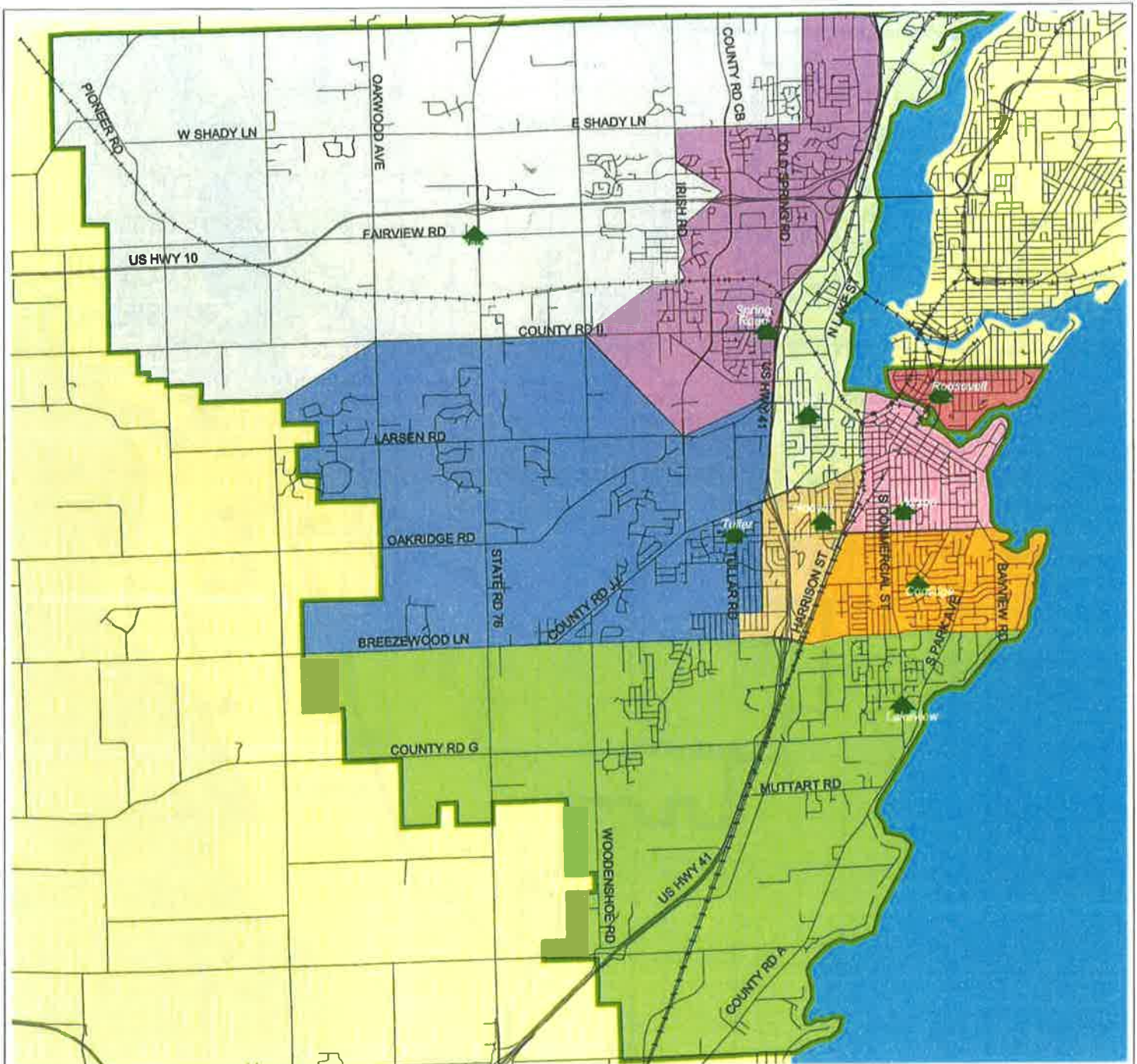

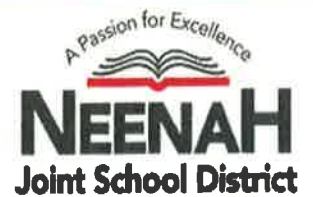

School Loads Based On Revised Boundaries

The following charts list for each school the number of full-sized classroom spaces (not including gymnasiums or multipurpose spaces), current school year number of kindergarten – grade 5 classrooms, 2014-15 projected kindergarten – grade 5 classrooms, enrollment range, number of students currently living in the school's attendance area, and load represented as the number of students living in the attendance area relative to the maximum capacity.

The kindergarten – grade 5 class size *range* will be 18-26 with the following *targets*:

- Kindergarten-grade 2 = 18-22 students
- Grades 3-5 = 20-24 students

Approximately 87 open enrollment students are not represented in the figures.

2,749 total K-5 students = 90.4% load (based on 127 classroom sections)
