We couldn't provide funding if it wasn't for your support and volunteer time at our school's events and programs. Without the volunteering and financial support of all of us through the PTO activities, none of this would be possible. Thank You!!!

This month we will be reviewing the proposed PTO budget for the 2017-2018 school year. I am sure you wonder what and why we fund raise every year... i.e. where does all the money go?

Did you know the standard PTO budget is typically \$4,000 and is allocated to the following general categories every year?

- 35% to assist Spring Road teachers in purchasing miscellaneous classroom supplies or replace items for the school year. We know our teachers spend their money to make their classrooms inviting and have everything they need to make our children excited and welcomed into their new classrooms every year. The PTO offers them a little bit of money to support them.
- 20% for accompanist for the music concert (if needed/required), books, prizes, and other various student activities throughout the school year.
- 20% for fall and spring socials and free activities at Spring Road Elementary to allow our parents and staff to see and get to know each other outside of school hours.
- 15% for a whole school enrichment activity of an author, speaker or STEM activity to come to our school. This is typically scheduled at the end of the year which will encompass learning or appropriate age-level entertainment for the entire student body to provide an enrichment opportunity for all Spring Road students.
- 10% is budgeted for miscellaneous items such as for PTO supplies for paper, envelopes and
 postage (for sending in Box Tops) and such for the year. If the money is not used then it is either
 rolled into the next year or placed into the PTO savings account depending on how the PTO
 votes to allocate any unused funds as discussed during the monthly PTO meetings.
