NEENAH HIGH SCHOOL LABORATORY SAFETY CONTRACT

The following rules and regulations will be used to ensure that a safe environment is maintained while in the science laboratory. Because of the potential for serious accidents in the laboratory, it is necessary to enlist the help of parents/guardians to impress upon students the need for following safe laboratory procedures. 1. Horseplay will not be tolerated.

- 2. Absolutely no food or beverages will be permitted in the room. Make-up is not to be applied in the lab.
- 3. Long hair must be tied back. No jackets or loose clothing allowed in the lab.
- 4. Safety goggles must be worn whenever Bunsen burners and/or chemicals are present or whenever directed by the instructor. **Safety Goggles will be purchased from the course instructor.**
- 5. Follow all directions (oral or written) given by the instructor.
- 6. Never taste anything in the laboratory. Touch and smell only with permission of the instructor.
- 7. Do not remove any lab equipment or chemicals from the room unless directed by your teacher.
- 8. Read all labels carefully and dispose of chemicals as instructed.
- 9. Do not touch any equipment prior to instruction. This means refraining from examining the equipment when you enter the room.
- 10. Follow all safety procedures and maintain caution and control in your experiment. If you have a question, ask your teacher.
- 11. Never engage in any activity that has not been specifically approved by your instructor.
- 12. Bunsen burners, lighter, and matches will be used only with the instructor's permission and directions. Keep your face, hair, and clothing away from the burner.
- 13. Always point sharp objects away from yourself and others. Cut away from your body.
- 14. Report all injuries, no matter how minor, to your teacher immediately.
- 15. Do not deface or write on woodwork, lab benches, or lab equipment.
- 16. Keep your work area clean at all times and return it to its original condition after each activity.
- 17. Know the location of the following pieces of safety equipment: eye wash station, fire extinguishers, safety shower, fire exit, and fire blanket.
- 18. Always wash hands before leaving the lab.
- 19. Do not work in the lab alone. An instructor must be present.
- 20. Maintain an ethical consideration when dealing with live specimens.
