

Neenah High School Evaluation Results

December 8th, 14th, 15th, 20th and 21st of 2017, Christine Ann's Education Specialist along with Reach Counseling addressed a total of 199 students between 6 separate classes, aged 13 to 18 at Neenah High School.

Topics addressed Domestic Violence, the Cycle of Violence, the Power and Control Wheel and the Man Box. Along with issues of 2nd Degree Sexual Assault, Sexual Harassment and Sexual Coercion. There was approximately 5 in a half hours of time spent within each of the classrooms presented to. As a result of this (innovative immersion?) education, THIS HAPPENED:

- * 95% of students have a better understanding of how to find help. Before presentation only 44% said they knew how to, 51 percent increase
- * 90% of students can now recognize and name four warning signs of an unhealthy relationship where only 33% were able to before, 57 percent increase of knowledge
- * 95% of students now said they were more confident in their ability to recognize abusive talk and behavior where before only 51% said they were confident, 44 percent increase

How We Measured the Results

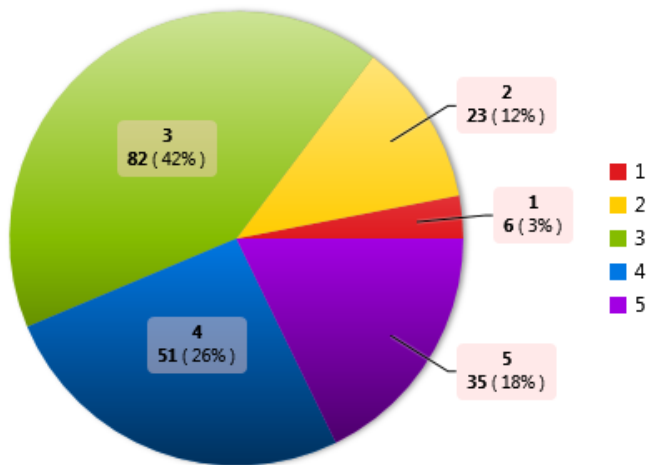
- * Pre and Post student surveys were handed out to each student
- * Success was then defined when students reported No Knowledge to Limited Knowledge on pre-survey and Basic to Full Understanding on the post-survey

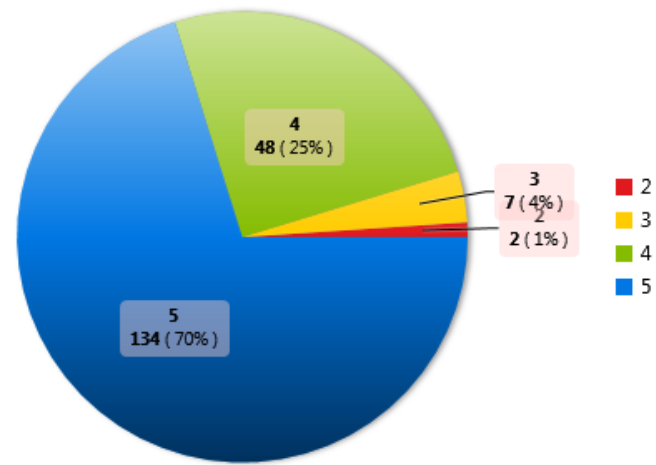
In a dating violence/sexual abuse situation, I know how to find help for myself or someone else.

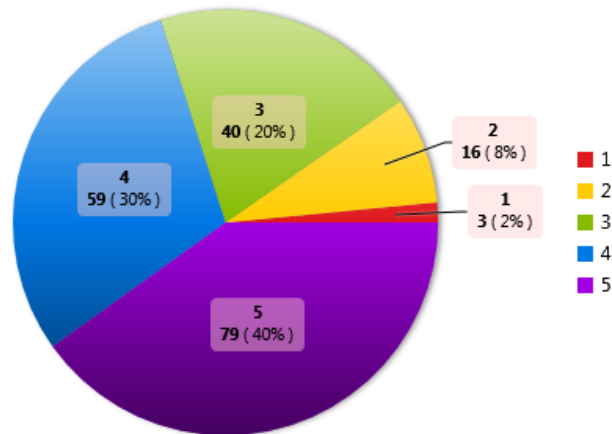

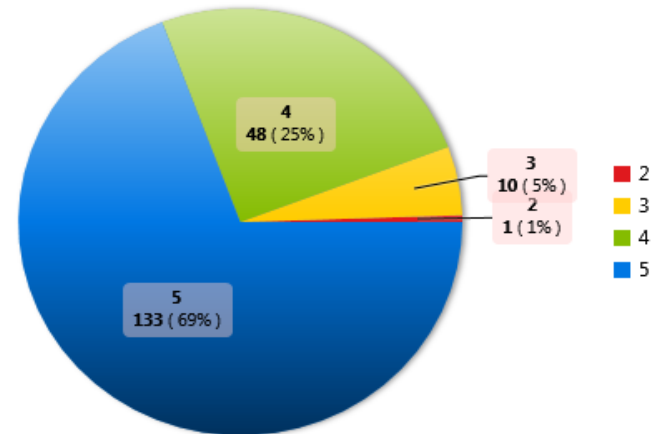
In a dating violence/sexual abuse situation, I am willing to help someone else.

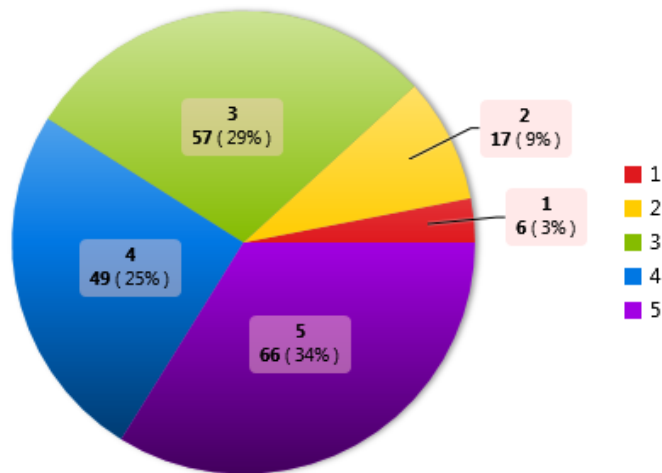

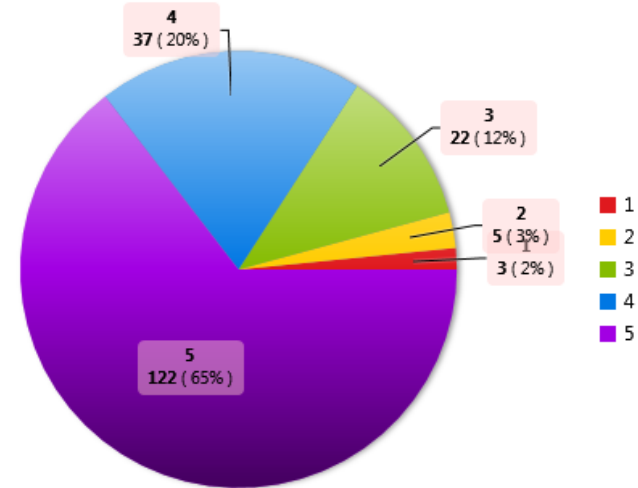
Dating violence/sexual violence is never the victim's fault

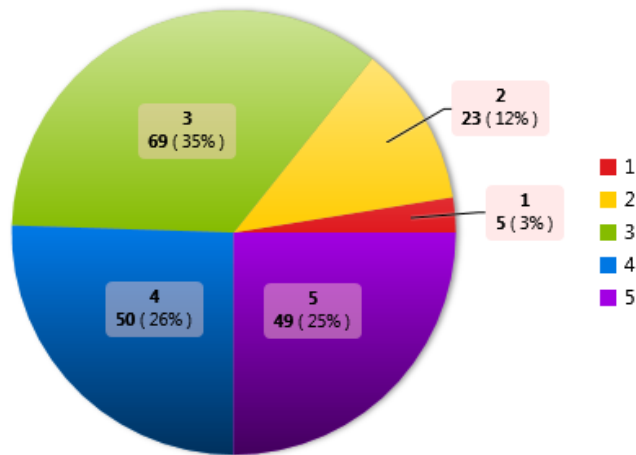

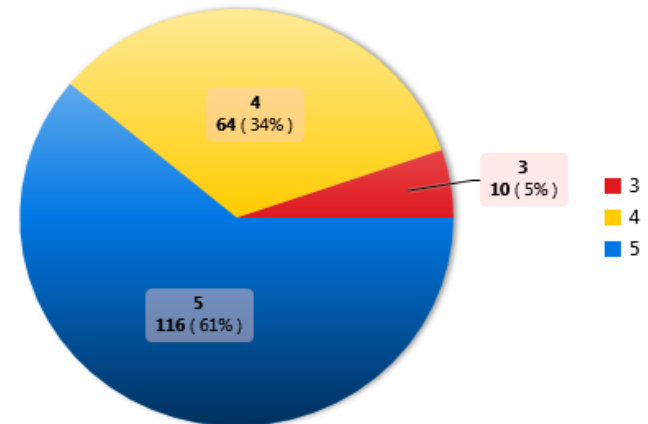
I am confident in my ability to recognize abusive talk, language and behavior.

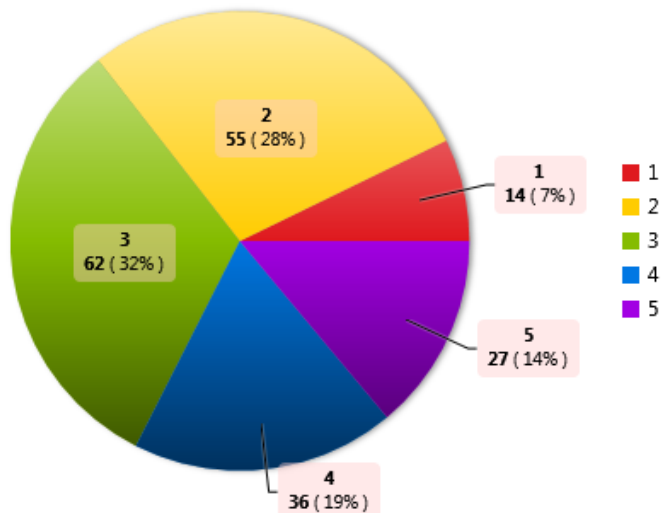

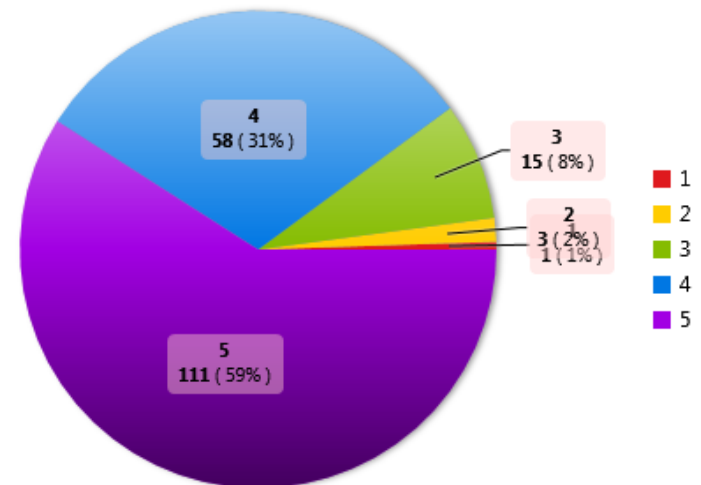
I recognize and can name at least 4 signs of an unhealthy relationship.

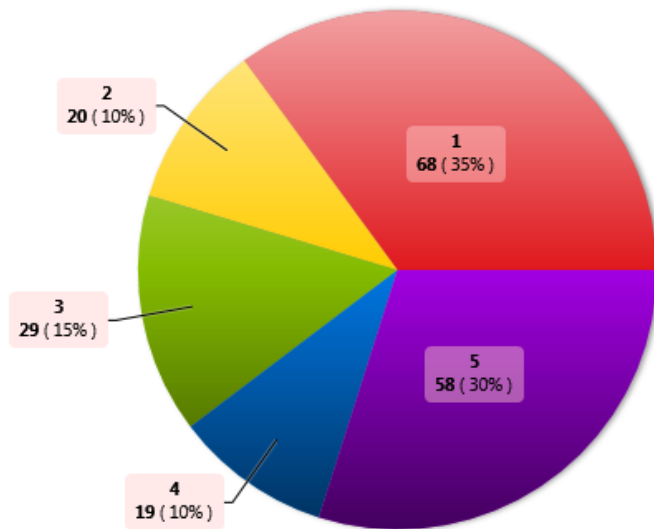

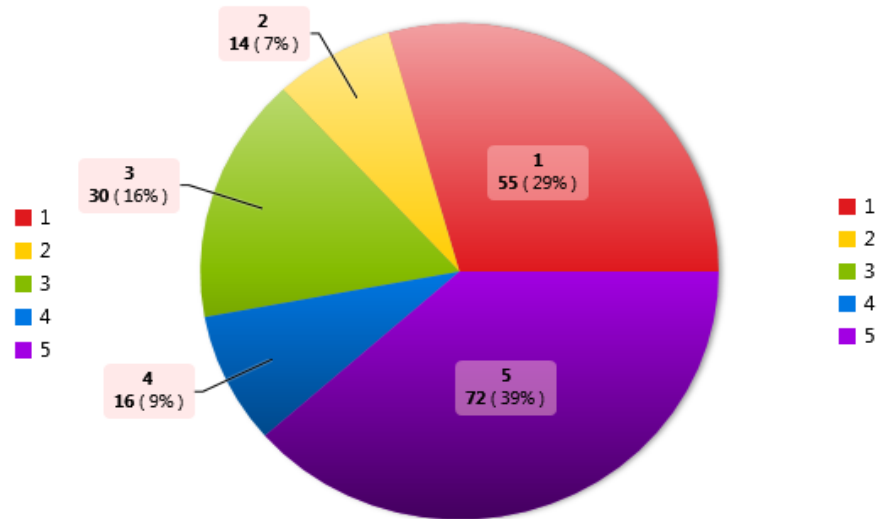
I have a friend who has experienced a physically, emotionally, verbally or sexually abusive relationship

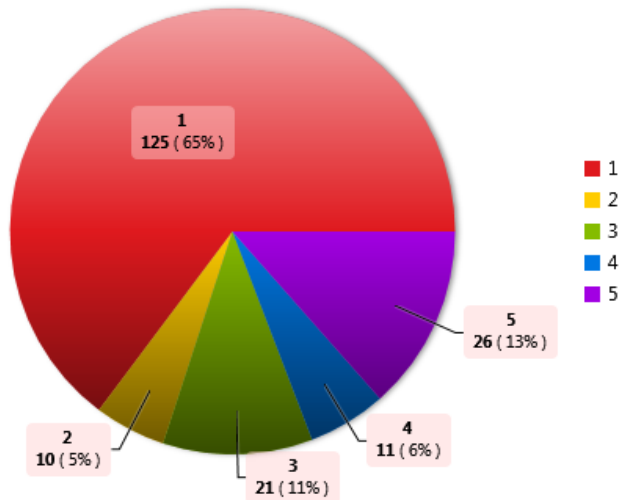

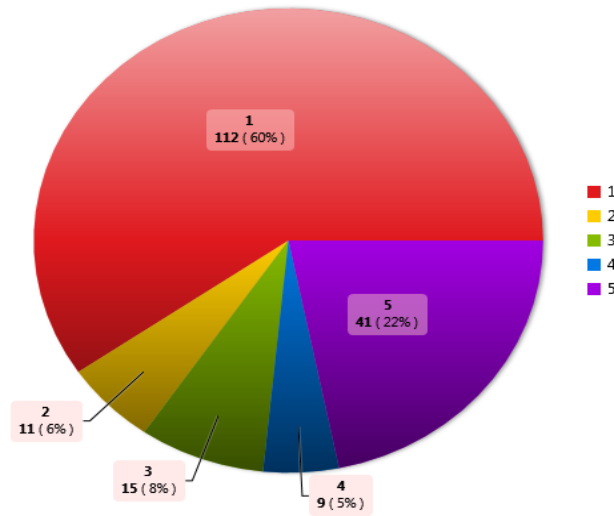

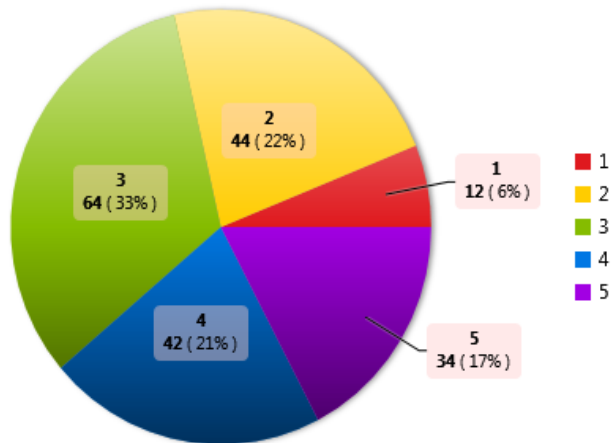

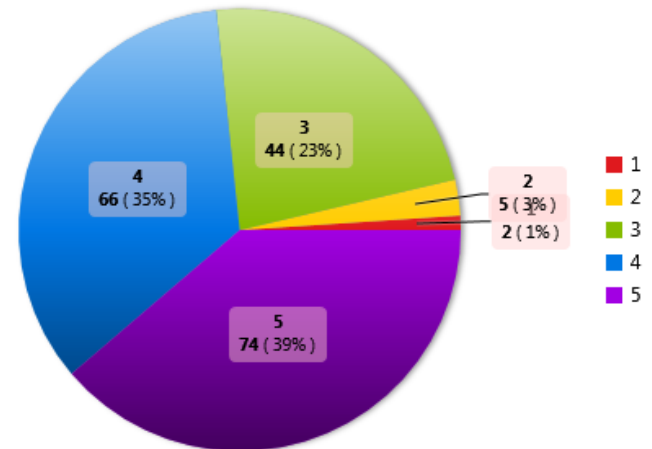
I feel comfortable standing up/speaking out when I encounter sexist language or demeaning behavior.

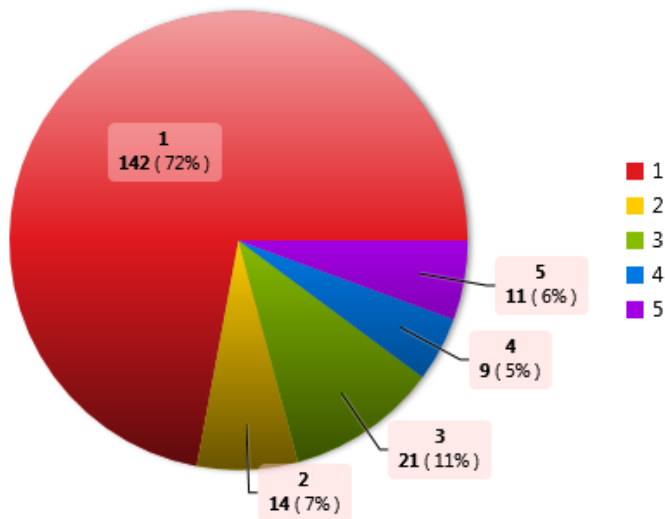

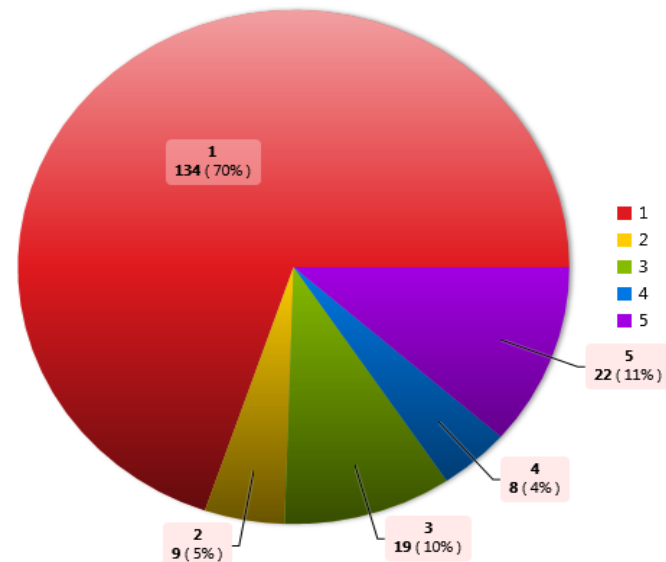

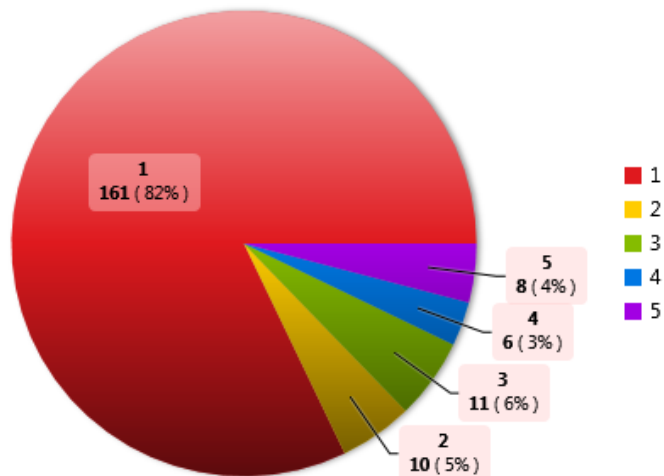

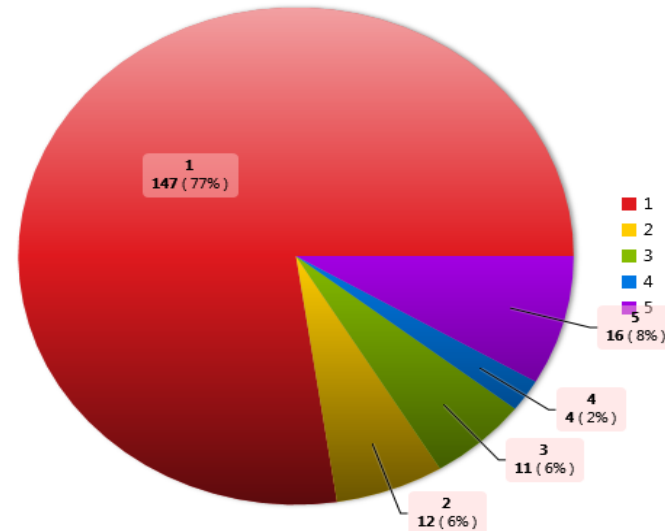

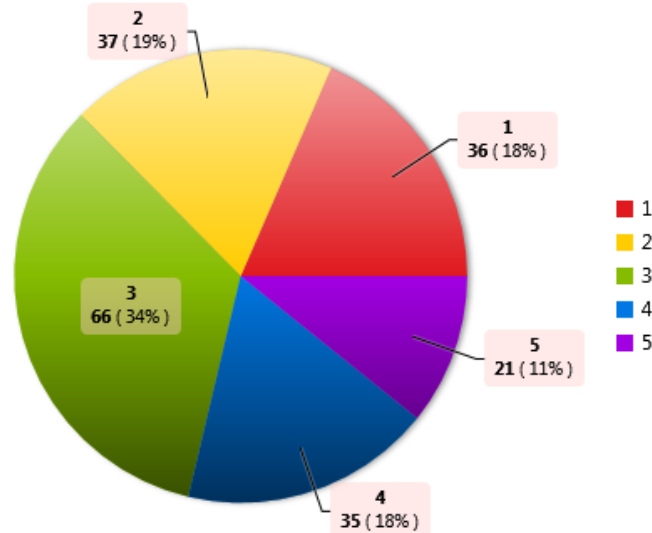

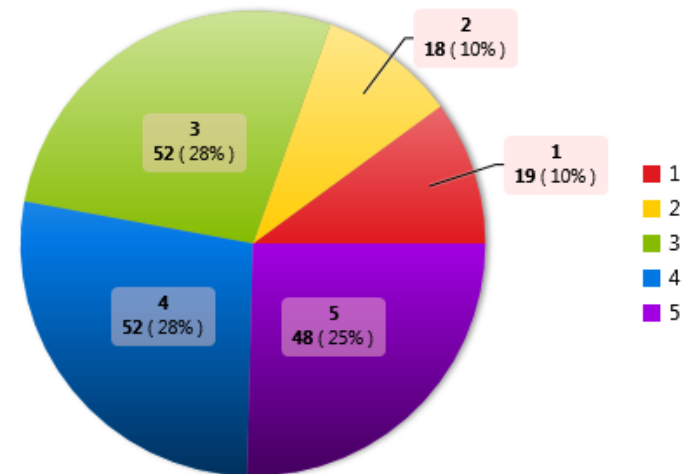
I have, or often do stand up and speak out when I encounter sexist language or demeaning behavior.
