Oshkosh Workshops

Parenting the Nurturing Way In-Person | Tuesdays 9/20-11/29 Meal 5:30-6:00 pm, Workshop 6:00-7:30 pm Plan to attend all 11 sessions Cost: \$35 | Caretakers of children prenatal-19 Evidence-based

This program is a series of lessons on managing & communicating feelings, positive discipline techniques, parenting with empathy, appropriate rewards & consequences, understanding growth & development, and helping your child/ren thrive. The program helps adult & adolescent parents identify areas in their parenting that could be strengthened and reassesses for growth during the program on 5 key parenting constructs.

Children ages 4-12 can be enrolled in our Kids Activity Group which when run has learning topics that mirror the parent workshops.Children 0-3 (or not yet potty trained) can be enrolled in on-site childcare.

All groups: parents, kids & childcare have maximum enrollments, so you must register all family members you want to be participating.

An optional group meal is served prior to the workshops for registered participants. An online, intake/orientation session can be scheduled August 26th, Sept 9th or 16th.
