- \*Haunted House volunteer as a scare-actor inside of Youth Go's Haunted House. All make-up, costumes, and training provided. You just have to show up with a positive attitude. Fridays and Saturdays from October 4<sup>th</sup> November 1<sup>st</sup> from 5:30-10:30pm (permission slip required!).

# **Education Program**

- \*Study Stars- homework time during the first 30 minutes at Youth Go M, T, and W.
- \*Homework Club- tutoring offered on Thursdays at Horace Mann in the Library from 3:15-5:15pm. Students are welcome to ride the "Activity Bus" to Horace Mann for Homework Club!
- \*Homework Lab- a quiet place offered nightly at the center during our high school hours.
- \*Monthly speakers on topics such as career exploration, the arts, or interesting hobbies.

# **Support and Wellness Program**

- \*One-on-one support from Youth Go staff members whenever you need someone to listen.
- \*GEMS/JAMS- peer discussion groups offered in 3 month sessions throughout the year.
- \*Nightly Meals- dinner is offered every night around 7pm.
- \*Monthly speakers on topics such as healthy relationships and making healthy choices.
- \*Community Service Club- volunteer opportunities available on Thursdays after school.

# When can you come to Youth Go?

Middle School Program (youth in 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade) Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 3:00-5:30pm Fridays from 3:00-8:00pm

**High School Program** (youth in 7<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grade) Mondays-Thursdays 6:00-10:00pm Fridays from 3:00-8:00pm

7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are invited to attend our Middle School Program or High School Program – some even attend both.

There are no membership fees and everything that takes place at Youth Go is FREE. Youth are not required to come any certain number of days each week and they don't have to stay the entire time. Youth Go is a drop-in center and our goal is to provide a safe and supportive place for youth to spend their time after school and in the evenings.
