- 3. The candidate must have achieved a 3.0 or better cumulative grade point average.
- 4. The candidate must plan to attend a college, university, or vocational or trade school.

Application Process

The candidate must present a completed application consisting of the following:

- 1. Application form (see attached.)
- 2. A copy of the candidate's current high school transcript.
- 3. A statement signed by the candidate's guidance counselor or by an administrative personnel representative certifying the candidate's cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation:
 - a. One letter from a staff member who is familiar with the candidate's performance and school activities.
 - b. One letter from a community member, outside the school setting, who is familiar with the candidate's involvement in community activities.
- 5. The deadline for submitting the completed application is March 16, 2012.
- 6. All applications must be submitted on the Roosevelt Elementary School form.
- 7. All blanks shall be completed in black ink or word processor form.
- 8. Use N/A, not applicable, where questions do not apply.
