Dear Parents,

Wasn't it great to see the recent snow? With our temperatures falling, I felt it an appropriate time to review our policies regarding students and their winter snow wear:

1. Students are always encouraged to wear the winter clothing that parents send them to school in.
2. For students to play in the field areas where there is snow, they **MUST** wear snow boots. These need to be different from the boots/shoes that they wear in school for the rest of the day. Students who choose not to wear boots are choosing to play on the blacktop area only.
3. We recommend that students wear snow pants or bib overalls to keep them as dry as possible, however, they are not required. Students who choose not to wear their snow pants may be choosing to have wet clothes.
4. Snowball throwing is always prohibited while on school grounds.

Thank you for your help in ensuring that your child(ren) are dressed appropriately to be warm and have the most fun in the snow.
